What does this mean for the coach?

As long as the coach remain registered on the class list, they will receive 'in training' status vs present 'untrained' status. Ontario Soccer will grant all of these coaches with 'in training' status dispensation, to coach their teams, and be placed on rosters until their rescheduled course has concluded. Providing the coach has Make Headway, Respect in Sport and Make Ethical Decisions training courses. All of which can be done online.

How long would this dispensation last for?

It would last until the end date of the course you are registered for. By then, your status will change to 'trained' once the course list is graduate on to the CAC Locker. Any coaches don't complete the course, will not be graduated, their status will go to untrained and they will no longer be eligible to coach.

What if I cannot make the new date?

The coach would be allowed to transfer to another available course, depending on availability and class size. This will be done by contacting Ontario Soccer's Coordinator of Coach Development; [Lyndon Hooper](#).

What does this mean for the host?

We will work with you to reschedule the course as originally intended. We will both need to do our best. You will need to find available dates and venues, we will find available facilitators.

What if the course is cancelled rather than rescheduled?

We want to avoid this as much as possible. We still want the coaches to be able to be safe in the knowledge that their course will still take place, and they can still coach their team during this transitional period. If a course is cancelled, the coaches on the course will not be eligible for dispensation. It would be too difficult for the Ontario Soccer Coach Development team to track all the individual cases. The coaches would need to register themselves on a new course, which could have limited availability, or put the coach in a position where they have to travel much further to attend a course.

Will extra coaches be allowed to register on these courses?

Yes. Still hosting the course, will allow other coaches to be able to join the original class list and hopefully fill up the course.
