 - a. Motion to approve minutes from Dec 2025 meeting >> motion passed

 - a. **Holiday Jamboree**
 - i. \$345 profit, approximately
 - b. **General Outlook**
 - i. All but one of the invoices have been paid
 - ii. Estimate for Winter 2026 - \$16,000 (Winter registration minus ice & JHO fees)
 1. 15 coaches for D tier; reimbursement not included in estimate for Winter season
 2. Estimate includes ice time for playoffs

3. Significant surplus predicted for this season
- c. Potential financial impacts of rink closure during time of heavy snow - Nate Ploof will hopefully be available at next meeting to discuss what this means for JAHA (hours, ice fees, etc.)
4. **Current season tier rep issues (all tier reps)**
 - a. **A - Simon Marks**
 - i. All good, no comments
 - b. **B - Jonas Lamb**
 - i. Has received some concerns about moving someone down to C tier. There are currently no spots available in C tier.
 - ii. Chrissy Coan may need to drop out due to injury. Will monitor and re-evaluate.
 - c. **C - Karsun Newport**
 - i. Has tried to reach out to an individual who had previously expressed interested in playing goalie in C - no response >> C tier still needs 1 goalie. Karsun is willing to play in net if this person / other person cannot be recruited.
 - d. **D - Caitlin Cardinell**
 - i. N/A, not present
 - ii. Karsun - several teams have not yet played a game due to rink closure
 - e. **Women's - Lauren Duehring**
 - i. All good, no comments. Few games played so far.
 - f. **35+ - Chris Coutu**
 - i. All good, no comments
5. **Rink Closure - Michelle Morris**
 - a. JAHA is giving up games on 18th and 19th >> giving up 3 sheets of ice but gaining 4 in exchange
 - b. Ploof has opened up 10:30 PM slots on Friday nights
 - c. JAHA should get all missed games back (have secured enough ice time to reschedule all cancelled games); teams not yet assigned for reschedules, need to coordinate to prevent double-games by teams
 - d. No need to reschedule or postpone playoffs
6. **Report on Try Hockey - Eli Barsy / Aaron Surma**
 - a. Intro to Hockey - First one was last week. Was able to convince some folks to sign up for Try Hockey
 - b. Try Hockey - Good experience. Lots of enthusiasm. Didn't get as many sign-ups, maybe because sign-up space was limited. Lots of women!
 - c. Michelle >> In the past, there were two women's tiers. Would the women at Try Hockey be more interested in joining a league if there were two separate women's tiers (maybe introductory Women's A and a more advanced Women's B?)
7. **Substitute Jersey Policy - Michelle Morris / Jonas Lamb**

- a. Disciplinary hearing was brought about by a reaction to a jersey that was seen as offensive - Does JAHA have a policy about potentially offensive jerseys being used by subs?
- b. Jonas - proposes that JAHA purchases practice jerseys (light and dark) for people to use when subbing
- c. Karsun - Was the issue about the player on the sub jersey or the team depicted on the sub jersey?
 - i. Issue was with both
- d. Eli - Are we the jersey police? Maybe some very broad rules could be applied, but enforcing these rules would also be difficult.
- e. Chris Coutu - Agree with Eli. No interest in being jersey police, and where would our jurisdiction end? (In the locker room? On-ice only? Outside the rink?)
- f. Deb - We're already losing actual team jerseys - do we want to provide open access to sub jerseys that won't be accounted for? The jersey in question is a nationally recognized team - are we open to the possibility of banning all JAHA members from wearing any other NHL team's jersey (or any JAHA team's jersey) when someone gets offended?
- g. Michelle - Jersey policing is hard, maybe bring it up to the refs if there's a potential issue. Black and white sub jerseys are a good idea but we have lots of similar colors playing each other (ex. Navy vs. green, yellow vs. white). Maybe a rainbow assortment of pinnie jerseys available for people to wear over their existing jersey?
- h. Dom - Michelle will get quotes for mesh pinnies, vote for Fall 2026 season on subs wearing only black/white jerseys with closest-match pinnie on top
