2021-2022 Registration Form – One form per family must be completed. The entire fee must accompany registration materials (or can be paid in full online via SportsEngine , but may be divided into two/three installments depending on what level of play if paying by check. Please make checks payable to LYHA. The registration form MUST be signed/initialed by BOTH parents/guardians to acknowledge review of the Handbook, Parent Code of Conduct, and Service Hours Agreement.

Consent to Treat – This form needs to be completed for each skater in case of injuries. Print more than one copy of this if you need.

Parent Code of Conduct – Please print and read this form. You will need to sign the form and initial the Registration Form stating that you have read and agree to adhere to its contents.

Service Hours – Please read the enclosed information on this form. You will also need to initial the Registration Form stating that you have read and agree to adhere to its contents.

The 2021-2022 LYHA Handbook – Please review the LYHA Handbook. A link to the most current version is available on the LYHA Website.

Register ONLINE with USA Hockey - USA Hockey requires all players to register with them. It is a simple process which requires a credit card. The fee is \$56 each for players age 7 and older. Please visit their registration website (https://www.usahockeyregistration.com/register_form_input.action) and follow the instructions provided.

Please print the confirmation page(s) after registering with USA Hockey and include this information in your registration packet. We will need to scan the barcode from that page to confirm your child is registered.

La Crescent YOUTH HOCKEY – COMMITMENT TO UPHOLD PARENT/GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT

I will fully comply with USA Hockey's Zero Tolerance Policy and Code of Conduct. La Crescent Youth Hockey interprets these provisions broadly and considers them to apply to any behavior that is disruptive to players, coaches, officials, volunteers, parents/guardians, opponents, and arena staff. Members are also responsible for the behavior of their guests and thus will be subject to discipline for any guest misbehavior. Examples of prohibited behavior for anyone include, but are not limited to:

1. Using obscene, vulgar, antagonizing, offensive, or boisterous language to anyone at any time.
2. Addressing a coach during a game, immediately following a game, during or immediately following a multi-game day or tournament to make a complaint. I understand that a 24-hour "cooling off" period is required.
3. Entering a dressing area/locker room without the coach's authorization, or blocking access to said area. (Exceptions on locker room entrance may exist where coaches grant permission to Mite and Squirt parents/guardians that may need to assist their child with dressing/undressing.)
4. Undermining the coach's authority by coaching from the stands or sidelines.
5. Engaging in any instance of verbal or physical abuse of a player, coach, spectator, arena employee, board, committee or other association member.
6. Making a scene in front of players or spectators at any time.
7. Entering the officials' dressing area, lingering outside their immediate area or making complaints to the officials.
8. Disobeying or showing disrespect for coaches' rules at tournaments regarding player curfew, swimming limits or restrictions on other activities. Team members attend tournaments for the express purpose of playing hockey.
9. Engaging in malicious gossip or behavior that is designed to create discord for others in the Association.
10. Being part of any activity that would involve the summoning of law enforcement officials.
11. Following COVID-19 Policy

I understand that my financial obligation to LYHA must be paid in full on the established payment deadlines or my player will not be permitted to skate. If I have a payment problem, it is up to me to notify LYHA to resolve.

I will not be critical of the coach or La Crescent Youth Hockey in front of my child or other team players. If I have a concern that I feel needs to be addressed, I will do so at an appropriate place at an appropriate time away from players and spectators. I will respect the coaches' decisions

and abilities. I will not interfere at any time with the duties and responsibilities of the coach. I will not put my child in the unfair position of having to decide who to listen to, me or the coach. La Crescent Youth Hockey fully understands issues may arise during the season and open communication is the key to a successful program. Everyone will best be served if we all handle these issues calmly and as adults.

I understand and will defer to La Crescent Youth Hockey's fair playing time provisions and other policies as described in the La Crescent Hockey Policy Handbook.

I support the belief that the most important aspect of my child's hockey experience is for him or her to have fun while developing physical skills, emotional maturity, interests and friendships that will serve them for life. I understand that there are more than 350,000 players registered with USA Hockey, 500,000 players registered in Canada, and thousands throughout the rest of the world. The odds of reaching the NHL are slim. La Crescent Youth Hockey is not about building NHL players. It is about building self- esteem, self-discipline, sportsmanship, and happy children.

I recognize that situations not specifically listed in the code of conduct may exist. I will abide by the Board's determination and resulting decisions on infractions that are detrimental to the Association and are determined to exist within the meaning of the USA Hockey Parent Code of Conduct and Zero Tolerance Policy.

I acknowledge that the Association Board will deal with violations of the code of conduct at its sole discretion, imposing penalties including but not limited to warnings, restitution, parent/guardian/player suspensions, and family expulsion. Refunds will not be given to players or parents/guardians suspended or expelled based on violations of the code.

I fully understand that my player will not be allowed to tryout or skate with LYHA until both spouses/guardians accept in total and sign the agreement, and it is received by the Membership Coordinator of La Crescent Youth Hockey.

Please sign the appropriate space on the Registration form showing you have received, read, understand, and will comply with this document, as well as the USA Hockey Zero Tolerance Policy.

SERVICE HOURS (2021-2022)

Q: Why do I have to work service hours?

Without volunteers we don't have hockey. Parent support is needed to perform duties that are needed in order to play games, raise revenues, and manage activities around the rink. We need **EVERYONE'S** support.

Q. What is my service hour's commitment?

We require a minimum 25 service hours for service hours for Mini Mite, Mite, Squirt, Pee Wee and Bantam teams, per family. These hours can include rink set-up and/or tear-down, coordinator position, concessions, coaches, board member, team manager, working golf outing, open skate, brat wagon, Applefest float, cleaning the rink, varsity game concessions, varsity game door, etc. **Each family is required to sign up for a mandatory session at the Applefest brat wagon and gun raffle.**

Q. How do I receive credit for those hours that I have worked?

As you work each set of your service hours, you will need to document your service hours in the binder that is located in the concessions stand. This is your responsibility to do so after every shift. The Volunteer Coordinator will tally the hours on a monthly basis. Hours will be posted on the website.

Q. What if I don't work the required 25 hours?

You will be charged \$20 for each hour not worked. The check that was written at registration will be cashed and you will be refunded the amount that you worked. Your refund will be accompanied by a bill with your total amount that was due at the end of the season. If there is a discrepancy in the recording of the service hours, it is your responsibility to provide documentation to the Volunteer Coordinator to have this corrected.

Q. Will the duties during my skater's home practices, games and home tournaments count towards service hours?

No. A concessions worker, scorekeeper, timer, two penalty box workers, and a person to resurface the ice must be provided by each team for all home games, practices and home tournaments. These hours will not count towards service hours. The team manager will be responsible for assigning these hours. Every family is required to work the games, regardless of having all service hours met. If you cannot make your assigned time it is your responsibility to find a substitute

Jersey Deposit Fees

\$100 fee per player: For the use of home and away games through the association. This fee is refundable at the end of the season, upon returning the jerseys clean and not damaged. If you do not return them clean and/or they are damaged you will not receive the deposit back.

Equipment Deposit Fees

\$200 fee per player: The Association owns and checks out equipment (skates, helmets, breezers, chest protects, elbow pads, shin guards, neck protectors, gloves, and sticks) for players to use during the season. Mini Mites and Mites are given priority for renting equipment. Depending on availability squirts players may also rent the equipment. This fee is refundable at the end of the season, upon returning the equipment at the end of the season and not damaged.

Volunteer Hour Fee

\$500 fee per family: Each family is required to perform a minimum of 25-hours. Service hours are posted on our website and are reserved on a first come, first serve basis. This fee is refundable at the end of the season, upon completion of the 25-hour requirement.

Fundraising Fees

\$400 fee per family: Each family is either required to sell \$400 worth of raffle tickets or to pay a \$400 fundraising fee if they choose not to sell tickets. The money you collect is yours to keep. Your check **will be cashed** at the end of the season either way.
