

## Additional Garfield Protocol

1) Also I need to remind everyone of the locker room policy that was attached to all contracts – please make sure parents, coaches and players understand the policy, if we experience any issues or problems, please know that all locker room privileges will be taken away/and or permit may be voided – we must **have 2 adults inside the room with the players at all times** – no sticks are allowed in the locker rooms, no food, no loitering, 6' apart – we have gotten through our 1<sup>st</sup> week of opening with a few issues already – even though this has been sent out to you – we need to make sure your coaches/parents know & understand our policy and not give the office staff a hard time, they are instructed to adhere to the policy, if you can't get parents to cooperate we will not issue a locker room key.

We ask that your players come fully dressed to the rink, with the exception of goalies – keep in mind, issued locker room is a privilege not a necessity.

If you haven't been here yet to see, we have had all locker rooms painted etc

**2) No out of State teams will be allowed for games etc.**, for this reason – not only are we requesting team rosters, we are also requesting your game schedules – to assure us you have not been out of Ohio recently & the team you are playing (even if local) hasn't been out of State.

This must be followed for our facility, as we are doing everything required by us to keep everyone safe & healthy. Rosters and schedules must be sent to me at least 3 days prior to any permit/game.

Our guidelines that have been mailed to all contracted patrons has been posted to the web page for everyone too see – at the time those were mailed out, we did not have our

capacity number, since then the Fire Marshall said **52 is our capacity for spectators**, so use the ratio - 1 parent per player is allowed inside – we are allowing Ohio teams to come to our facility for now, but please keep in mind – this is subject to change at any moment if all guidelines are not followed, if you are having a team from a distance, they must be told in advance that 1 parent is allowed in – others may have to sit outside in the car, we cannot let more than 52 spectators in, even if they traveled a distance.

Our Mayor is adamant about all of our policies being adhered to at all times – this is for the health and safety of everyone
