RULES

Coaches must check in at concession table when you arrive!!!

Facility will open at 7:30am-**OUTSIDE DOORS WILL NOT BE OPEN BEFORE THAT**

Bring your own volleyballs and please make sure they are labeled

Team camp areas will be labeled in the back of the commons area.

Warm up for each teams' first match: 10 minutes (2-4-4); 2 minutes shared—4 minute serving team—4 minute receiving team

Warm Up for ALL following Matches: 5 minutes (1-2-2) 1 min shared, 2 mins serving team, 2 mins receiving team

TEAMS WILL REMAIN ON THE SAME SIDE OF THE COURT FOR THE ENTIRE MATCH. No switching sides between sets

Refing team must provide: R1, R2, 2 line judges, libero tracker, score book keeper and score chart person.

Coach must be the R1 for 11-14s. Coach must be either the R1 or R2 for 15-18s.

A coach is encouraged to be R1 for bracket play at ALL AGES

There will only be a replay called if ball comes onto the court that interferes with play

Athletes are allowed to step into the other court if it does NOT INTERFERE with play. This is a judgement call by the ref

All match start times are approximate and warm ups will begin immediately after conclusion of previous match

All teams are guaranteed minimum of 4 matches

Concessions will be available - NO COOLERS OR OUTSIDE FOOD ALLOWED

Tournament t-shirts will be for sale (short sleeve \$15, long sleeve \$20)

Admission: \$10 adults, \$5 students and senior citizens, 12 years and younger FREE (CASH ONLY)

All Pool Play Matches: 2 sets to 25, NO CAP

Each pool play match is worth 3 points. 1 point for each set won and 1 point to team who earned the most points. Example:

Team A wins 25-13 and then Team B wins 25-20. Team A earned 45 points and Team B earned 38 points. Team A would receive 2 pool points, and Team B would earn 1 pool point. If it is a tie (25-13 then 13-25), each team would receive 1.5 points.

Pool seedings will based on 1. Most pool points 2. Head to Head 3. +/- Points 4. Coin Flip

Top two seeds (8 total) of each pool will go on to Gold Bracket

Bottom two seeds (8 total) of each pool will go on to Silver Bracket

Bracket play matches: Best of 3 with 3rd to 15 pts. No cap

Bracket play will start at approximately 1:00pm, or earlier, if all teams are ready to start per court

Awards will be given to Champions in Gold and Silver Bracket

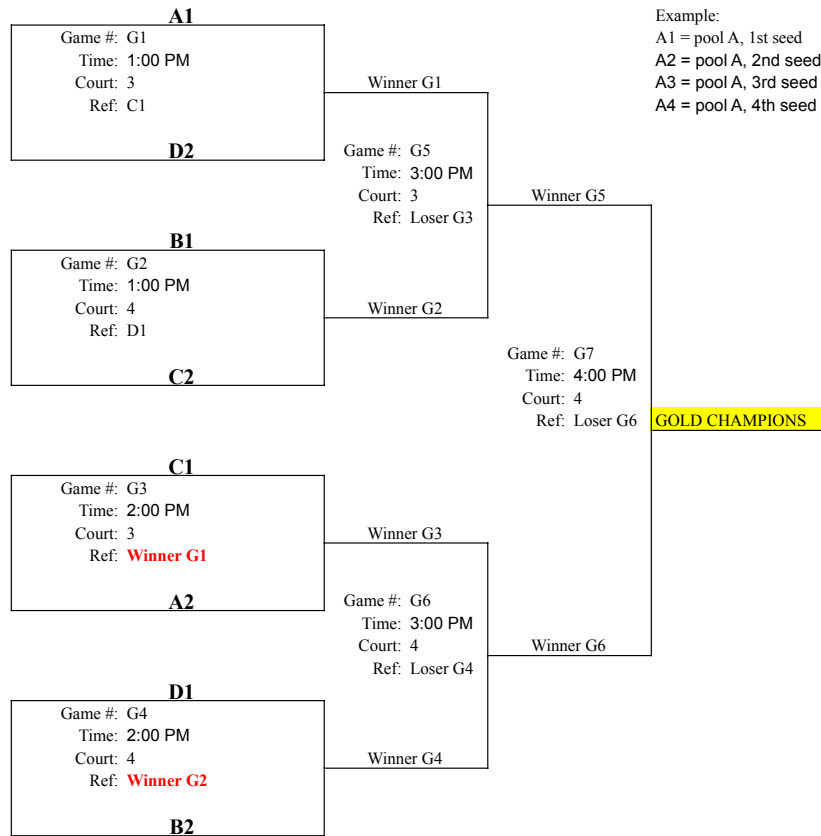

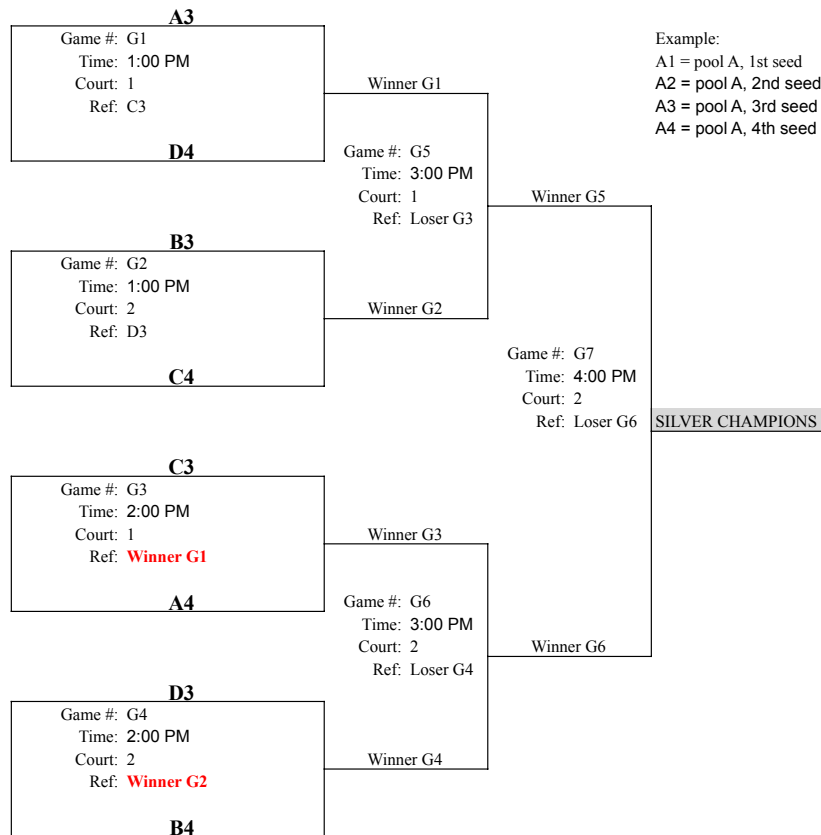
ATTACK 13/14s GOLD BRACKET

Find your team on left column and read across. First score listed is the team in left column. Second score listed is the team on the top row

Each match consists of 2 sets. Each match is worth 3 total pool points. Earn 1 pt for each set won, team who earns most points wins the third pool play point. If same total points, 1.5 pool point each

Each pool (court) will have their own pool sheet listed in the hallway and updated throughout the day

Examples:

Team A wins against Team B 25-12 and 25-20. Team A earns 3 pool points, Team B earns 0 pool points

Team A wins against Team B 25-12 and then loses 10-25. Team A earns 1 pool point, Team B earns 2 pool points. Team A scored 35 points, team B scored 27 points

Team A wins against Team B 25-12 and then loses 12-25. Team A earns 1.5 pool points, Team B earns 1.5 pool points. Both teams scored 37 points.

Example:

A1 = pool A, 1st seed

A2 = pool A, 2nd seed

A3 = pool A, 3rd seed

A4 = pool A, 4th seed
