1. Tami called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Jon Holmes joined us for this meeting to talk over Tiger Scramble details.
2. Meeting minutes from 6/21/17. Rochelle made a motion to accept minutes. Sandy seconded. Motion passed.
3. Treasurer's Report (Rochelle)
  - a. Our account balance is \$33,185. A payment was made for a new set of battery percussion. Income is coming in for band camp meals and Tiger Scramble registrations.
  - b. End of fiscal year balance was \$36,209.11. Our biggest expense this past year was uniforms, followed by the marching show.
  - c. Reminder-get a tax exempt card from Rochelle for any purchases.
4. Director's Report (Erin, Brad)
  - a. MB season-The schedule this year for band camp is different in order to avoid sharing space with JAX. The band will be providing music at the start of the Tiger Scramble. Students will need to carpool to the golf course.
  - b. Hawaii-The 2nd payment is due on July 25th. 121 students have committed to the trip. An e-mail will be sent next week to parents with more details about the trip. One change-The band will be leaving one day earlier than originally planned and getting back a day earlier.
  - c. New battery percussion instruments were purchased. The cost included all harnesses and cases.
  - d. Lockers-The district will be adding some new band lockers for the upcoming school year.
5. Fundraising Report (Sue C.)
  - a. Urban Revival-The new apparel, with logos created by Ben, are on the website. Once the page is active we will encourage parents/students to make a purchase.
  - b. Lanyards-Sue is looking into have Urban Revival make these for us to sell.
  - c. Parent night out-We discussed holding a night out at an establishment in the area (Celts, Bourbon Butcher, Carbones); part of the proceeds would go back to the band.
  - d. Another possibility for a new fundraiser is selling stadium blankets.
  - e. Heggies-September kick-off date is September 11th. Jacalyn will confirm a delivery date; likely October 12th.
  - f. Other opportunities: Tami was approached by Craig Johnson with the idea of teaming up for a mattress fundraiser. The sale is set for February 24th from 10-6. Last year's sale profited \$5,500. Responsibilities would include advertising the sale on social media and volunteering the day of the sale. A decision to move forward has been tabled for a future meeting,
6. Tiger Scramble (Dan)
  - a. Teams-13 1/2 teams signed up so far.

- b. Gifts/Food-All golfers will receive either a mug or tumbler and a golf towel as a gift. Cheryl Wason (golf parent) is taking charge of all the food needs. Leftover food will be used at the DCI show the following Tuesday.
  - c. Volunteers-Still need several student volunteers to work the hole games.
  - d. New this year-We are getting a banner this year to welcome golfers; can be used each year.
  - e. Other-Details are being worked on for registration table volunteers, hole game volunteers.
7. DCI (Sandy)-Waiting for information from Minnesota Brass. Once Sandy knows the inventory left from Tiger Scramble, she will be purchasing needed supplies.
8. Marching Band Updates
- a. Band Camp-Heidi has meals all set. Monday's meal will be a pasta bar in place of Pizza Man. Price per person will be about the same as last year. All volunteer spots for that week have been filled.
  - b. Volunteer needs-One more volunteer is needed for the state fair. Decisions about volunteer needs for Youth in Music will be made soon.
  - c. Props-Dean has been looking into different platforms.
  - d. Parade Banner-We are waiting for a mock-up of the banner; hoping to have the banner by the state fair parade.
9. Tiger Fan Club Report (Tami)
- a. September 9th-new fundraiser premier. Each booster will need to provide volunteers and silent auction items. More details to come.
  - b. Any fundraising profit made during the past fiscal year will be distributed to booster clubs in August.
10. Other-Tami reminded us that when we are in the band area and around students, we need to maintain professional behavior. We should also be allowing the students to take ownership of their uniforms, instruments, etc. so they can become more independent and able to teach the underclassmen.
