**Secretary's Report:**

Marcy motioned to accept May minutes, Karen 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. All in favor.

**Treasurer's Report:**

**State Report:**

Kick-off 8/28 for the state meeting. This is subject to change.

USA Hockey is changing their fee structure for the USA Hockey membership. Tier system based on age. Karen is going to clarify it – VSAHA is saying 6 and under is free but USA Hockey says \$15, \$55, \$66, \$75 – per child's age level. (This includes the \$5 fee for VSAHA) This takes place for the 2022-2023 season.

Karen attended the Milton meeting on 6/12. 5 families that have kids at the squirt level with no place to play. Karen let them know that there is nothing saying that a 9-year-old cannot play U8's. Have all 8- and 9-year old's play mites this year to get more skill under their belt as they did not get to play any half ice games. Aaron told them they needed to let MAHA know by 7/1 if they are going to transfer to our organization or not. MYHA is meeting tonight as a board and will put that suggestion out to see how the board feels.

**Fundraising:**

- eBike Raffle - All 250 tickets were sold. Roughly \$4500.00 profit. Subtract the cost of printing the tickets.
- Gun Raffle:
  - Discuss Registration to set a date to start selling the gun raffle tickets. Also, how many tickets will be mandatory per family to sell. Maybe set it up as an incentive to members – sell more and get entered in a raffle to win a prize?
  - 10 guns to raffle off. Could be a chance for a person to win more than one gun.
  - Maybe setting up times to come and drop money off to Judy at the rink so that there isn't such a need to set up payments being all electronic.
  - Open registration potentially 7/15 – 8/31?

Elev802 clinic is being cancelled. Angela is going to reach out to them and let them know of the cancellation. Judy is going to reimburse the families from our website.

Dry run game on 8/21 for street hockey. Karen has the rink penciled in for that date.

50/50 Raffle while Corey's band is playing in the park in Highgate. Get our organization out there. The concerts start the Sunday after 7/4 and go until the Sunday after Labor Day. Everything starts around 4:30, and then the band goes on at 6:30. Could potentially sell tickets for the gun raffle there as well. Open this up to members to work general hours?

Angela knows someone who may potentially be able to re-do our logo to us and make us a new banner. Angela would donate the banner to the organization.

Bottle drive – do it yourself. 7/9 and 7/10 – take pictures of yourself bringing bottles into the Hometown Sunoco, and that will enter yourself into win a 50-dollar gift certificate. Picture frame, or banner to take their picture in front of at the Sunoco? Funniest picture wins a prize? Wear the shirts that progressive donated?
