

# CCJAA 2020 Game Day Protocols



- 1) Face coverings are required to be worn in all commonly used areas.  
Coaches will be required to wear face-coverings at all times. The facility crew and staff will be required to wear a face covering. If an individual wished to enter the facility but is without face cover, one shall be provided to them for a fee of \$1.00. OTHERWISE, NO MASK NO ENTRY.
- 2) Spectator face coverings will remain on for the duration of the event to remain current per Cass County Health Department guidelines.
- 3) Players may remove face-covering if the following criteria are met:
  - a) The player is on the field during play
  - b) The Player has a helmet on
- 4) Temperature checks are required for every facility entrant. Staff and spectator no exceptions. Watch for fever (temp of 100.4°F or higher).
- 5) Spectator limitations will be enforced. Spectators request forms to be disbursed weekly by coaches to parents. Parents will fill out the names of people to enter the stadium on behalf of their athlete. Limit of 3 spectators per athlete/Coach. Parents will present this document up the entrance into the stadium. This will also help with contact tracing.
- 6) Coaches wearing badges, referees, and players wearing game jerseys will be allowed to enter the stadium no sooner than 1 hour before game time.
- 7) CCJAA members are to ask all spectators if they or any members of their immediate family have been in close contact with anyone that has tested positive for COVID-19 or are at risk of carrying the illness. Please ask the following questions:
  - a) Have you, or anyone in your family, been in close contact with a person that has tested positive for COVID-19?
  - b) Have you, or anyone in your family, been in close contact with a person that is in the process of being tested for COVID-19?
  - c) Have you, or anyone in your immediate family, traveled outside of the USA within the last two (2) weeks?
  - d) Are you having trouble breathing, have a dry cough, or have flu-like symptoms?
- 8) Per CDC recommendations, if any answer is "yes", the individual will be asked to leave the facility immediately and will not be allowed to return to the without a doctor's letter verifying healthy status.
- 9) Once your game is over, you will be required to exit the facility. Post-game conversations between coaches/teams will be handled outside the field area or during your next practice to allow spectators to more quickly exit and upcoming spectators to enter.
- 10) Event spectators will be asked to remain in the parking area, and appropriately distanced until the stands are cleared of the previous team's fan base exits the facility. Please DO NOT gather at the entrance.
- 11) Event spectators may enter 10 minutes before game time. This will allow sufficient time for spectators to leave the prior game.
