RE: Revisions to Welcome Letter on March 4th

Coaches/schedulers,

Please pass along to the teams or remind them that the complete Lakeview COVID rules are posted on our website. **Due to the recent COVID outbreak at the AA Districts, we have been directed to strictly adhere to the policies.** We are working VERY hard to keep Lakeview open to extend our season and have ice until June. (You are all welcome to rent some!) Please help us keep it open by doing your part.

We have gotten a lot of phone calls, texts, etc. in regard to if we are allowing more spectators or not this weekend. Our rink has not changed their policy, so it is still 2 spectators per coach and player. **This means 2 - not 2 plus a sibling.**

Also, **EVERYONE** must wear masks at all times **no exceptions** (i.e., vaccinated already, health reasons). Unfortunately, the City of Marquette sets the rules, and we need to follow them. The City of Marquette has set the policy, you will get one warning and then asked to leave the building. The players on the ice must also wear masks at all times. Officials will send the player to the bench to put a mask on.

Please do not congregate in the building before or after the game. The City of Marquette follows the 6 feet apart guidelines.

With the recent news of what happened in Calumet a few weeks ago this will not change anyone minds of the number of spectators or the mask policy.

Please be kind to the people checking you in at our tracing table - they are just parents who are volunteering their time and did not make the rules. So, let us make this a great tourney and have some great hockey!!

MJH asks that each team provide documentation of who is attending, including the spectators' name and phone numbers in a spreadsheet format (example attached). This is due by THURSDAY.

Lakeview Arena COVID-19 Preparedness Plan

Lakeview Arena and the City of Marquette are committed to providing a safe and healthy workplace for all our staff and guests. To ensure safety, we have developed the following COVID-19 Preparedness Plan in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. This plan is in conjunction with both state and City COVID-19 guidelines and policies. All staff members are responsible for implementing this plan. User groups are encouraged to help with implementation by informing their participants. Our goal is to mitigate the potential for transmission of COVID-19 in our ice arena and community; this requires full cooperation among our staff and our guests. Only through this cooperative effort can we establish and maintain the safety and health of our Lakeview Arena community. This preparedness plan will remain fluid and will be subject to changes, as necessary.

Employee Screening and Lakeview Guest Self Checks

Employees of Lakeview Arena will follow the City's plan for daily COVID-19 monitoring. Guests of the rink will be asked to go through a self-check health screening. Self-Check Health Screening information sheets will be placed at all entrances and various locations through the arena. Guests should review the checklist upon entering. If guests are experiencing any of the COVID-19 symptoms on the list, they are not to enter the facility:

- Have you recently been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19?
- Do you have a fever (100.4 F or higher) or are you feeling feverish?
- Do you have a cough?
- Do you have any shortness of breath?
- Do you have a sore throat?
- Do you have any muscle aches?
- Do you have a headache?
- Do you have a loss of smell or taste?

Mask Requirements

Staff and guests will be required to always wear masks while in Lakeview Arena. In accordance with state orders, masks must be worn while participating in on ice activities. The masks worn for on ice activities must meet the Michigan Athletic Hockey Association (MAHA) standards. The following are exemptions:

- A tenant of Lakeview Arena while in their own rented space. Tenants and users are encouraged to have their own mask policies.
- A staff member of Lakeview Arena while at their own workstation. Mask are required if another person enters the workspace.

Building Capacity

The number of people allowed in Lakeview Arena will be determined by the current orders from the City, MAHA, MHSAA and State of Michigan. This number will be posted throughout the building. It will be a group effort among Lakeview staff and the user groups to ensure that the number is not exceeded. If the number is exceeded, Lakeview staff will work with the user groups to bring the number back into compliance.

Spectators at the rink are encouraged to have at least 6 feet of distance between their party and other spectators' parties.

For games and competitions, in accordance with state orders, each coach/player may have 2 guests.

Building Entrances and Exits

There will be separate entrances and exits. Entrances and exits will be marked with signage. They will also be identified on the facility map.

Entrances include:

- Main entrance into lobby
- Main doors on the north side of Lakeview (back)

Exits only doors include:

- Citizen Forum doors
- All other emergency exits in the facility.

The Superior Hockey doors will remain both entrance and exit doors.

Loitering

Guest of Lakeview are asked not to loiter at the rink or in the parking lot. Rink guests should arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to their scheduled ice time and stay no longer than 15 minutes past their scheduled ice time.

Mezzanine Shooting/Workout Areas

The shooting/workout areas located in the west mezzanine will be closed. A person wishing to conduct a dryland workout may do so by scheduling a time with the Parks and Recreation office. There will be no charge and the users shall disinfect equipment after use.

Drinking Fountains and Water Bottles

Drinking fountains will be turned off with exception to bottle filling stations. Groups are encouraged to plan to have personal water bottles filled before entering the building. Each guest should have their own water bottle and water bottles are not to be shared.

Locker Rooms

Locker rooms number assignments for the whole weekend are:

There is a High school game on Friday night so rooms 5-8 might be subject to change. Players and Coaches are only allowed in the locker rooms. Parents can tie players skates outside of the locker rooms on chairs. **The lobby is not to be used as an area to put on skates.**

Cleaning and Housekeeping

Lakeview Arena staff will conduct frequent cleaning and disinfecting. Commonly touched surfaces, such as door handles and railings, will be disinfected several times throughout the day. A member of the staff will be assigned to disinfecting duties and will make continuous rounds throughout the building to disinfect surfaces as able. Restrooms will be deep cleaned several times daily. Locker rooms will be disinfected after each use.

Contact Tracing

Each user group will designate a person or group to oversee contact tracing. User groups will be required to maintain daily records, including name, phone number, date and time of entry and exit of facility to aid with contact tracing. Failure by an individual to provide this information may lead to denied entry to the facility.

Traveling and Visiting Teams

Teams visiting the rink should be limited only to teams from Michigan's Upper Peninsula and the Northern portion of Lower Michigan or District 8 and 6 of Michigan's COVID districts. All Lakeview staff will follow the current City travel policy. Staff must disclose to their supervisor if they are traveling out of the Upper Peninsula. Any arena guest, user, or team traveling outside of the Upper Peninsula should self-quarantine for 14 days or receive a COVID-19 test upon return to the area and should not enter Lakeview Arena until one of the two is met.

Refund for Lost Ice Due to COVID-19 Shutdowns

Full refunds will be issued to groups if booking(s) are cancelled due to any COVID-19 related shutdowns.

Even with these precautions in place, Lakeview Arena cannot eliminate all risks associated with the COVID-19 pandemic. By choosing to make use of this facility, user groups and guests are assuming a risk they may contract the COVID 19 virus despite the Lakeview Arena's best effort to provide a clean and safe environment.
