



## 2019 Prior Lake Spring Basketball

Laker Basketball based out of Prior Lake is preparing for the Spring AAU Boys Basketball season. We are excited about our program and the prospects of growing our organization in 2019. Current Prior Lake High School and other quality coaches will coach the teams at the different levels from 4<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> grades. We invite all levels of in house and traveling boy basketball players to participate. Teams will play 6+ local tournaments. Most tournaments will be AAU sanctioned. We want all players committed to playing with and against better competition. If you are a current Prior Lake Boys basketball player, this is ideal for continued skill development using our current offensive & defensive philosophies in game situations.

Tryout date is Tuesday March 19<sup>th</sup>. Teams will be posted March 21<sup>th</sup>.

Tryout's will depend on how many players are registered, we are hoping to have 2 teams per grade level with 10 players per team. If there are 25 players per grade, we will have tryouts with that grade level. 1. We will practice 2x/week on Tuesday's and Thursday's in the evening to avoid conflicts with baseball, lacrosse and track and field. Coaches will contact you before the first practice which is on March 26<sup>th</sup>.
2. Tournaments begin in April and conclude in June. This should not conflict with spring break.
3. The cost per player is \$450 which includes practices, minimum of 6 tournaments (18+ games), shooting shirt/game shorts, string backpack, coaches & gym fees. Game jersey will be provided and returned at end of season.
4. PLHS coaches and other coaches determined by the coaching staff will coach the teams. These coaches are very familiar with the system PLHS Basketball currently teaches to its players. Each team will also have a volunteer parent coach and a volunteer team manager.
5. Continued skill development for the players being coached by the high school coaches.
6. Teams at each grade level will be determined by the number of players trying out and skill level. Boys will be participating at their current grade level, players could play up which is determined by the coaching staff.
