

Parents Code of Conduct

All parents want their kids to do well and have fun in the activities they pursue. We want you to be actively involved in positive ways with your child's athletic experiences with PJFC. To do that, you need to first understand your responsibilities as a parent of a child in PJFC:

- Let the coaches do the coaching. The Coaches are there and are the authorized representatives of your team.
- Remember all coaches are volunteering their time and putting hard work to make sure your child has the best experience playing football.
- Keep all comments to players, other parents, officials, and coaches of either team positive ones.
- Never use any inappropriate language.
- Cheer for your team, and show interest, enthusiasm, and support for your child.
- Be in control of your emotions. Expressing displeasure has never changed an official's call and will not be tolerated. Any outburst with inappropriate behavior in anyway can result in you being asked to leave the premises. Multiple offenses will result in banishment from the league for the season.
- Recognize that referees are authorized to be in control of the game. The only thing parents are in control of is how they choose to react.
- Never approach a referee for any reason, before, during or after a game.
- Respect and execute instructions given by coaches and administration in a thankful way that help make our program a success.

There will be a Zero-Tolerance policy for any disrespectful behavior or non-sportsman like misconduct towards players, other parents, referees, board members or coaches. Any parent who cannot follow this, will be asked to leave, and will not be permitted to return until PJFC Board Representative gives the approval. Multiple offenses will result in that individual being banished from the league and not permitted to return for the remainder of the season.
