

- I/We, the parent/guardian of the above named candidate, hereby give my/our approval to participate in the Pembroke Pines Optimist Cheerleading program.
- I/We understand these activities could cause injury, paralysis, or possible death.
- I/We assume all risk and hazards incidental to such participation, including transportation to and from the activities; and do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless the Pembroke Pines Optimist, the AYFLC, City of Pembroke Pines volunteers, sponsors, participants and persons transporting my/our child to and from activities; for any claim arising out of an injury to my/our child, whether the result of negligence or from any other cause, except to the extent and in the amount covered by accident and liability insurance.
- I/We shall furnish a certified birth certificate and sports physical for the above named candidate.
- My child and my family will abide by the rules of the American Youth Football League Cheerleaders (AYFLC,) and Pembroke Pines Optimist (PPO) and will promote good sportsmanship.
- I understand/agree that cheerleading is a team sport, and that missing practices, camps or games is harmful to the team.
- I understand/agree that the coaches, staff and program directors are volunteers and should be shown respect at all times.
- I understand/agree that by removing my child from a team or allowing my child to quit will hurt their teams chances at competition.
- I understand/agree that my child will participate in competition in October - December and girls must stay until competition is over.
- I understand that the game uniform is Property of PPO and needs to be cared for by instructions given. Also, uniforms may need to be shared or swapped to accommodate everyone until everyone has a uniform.
- I understand that if my child loses, destroys or does not turn in her uniform at the end of the season, that I am financially responsible for its replacement. Failure to comply with this waiver will result in my child not being able to cheer next year at this park or any other AYFLC park. I understand that all financial obligations must be met by given deadlines, or my child will not be able to participate until met.
- I understand that my child will be required to compete in the state cheerleading competition in December if they win a Bid.
- I understand that the raffle tickets are to reimburse myself for some of the registration expenses and can be sold or just filled out and turned in by due date.

- I understand cheerleading for football does not end until after the Super Bowl games.
