Registration Opened September 15th, early bird ended October 15th, 8U now \$440 and 10U-14U is now \$495. Sibling discount still available at \$50 off

Learn to Play November 2nd - December 19th (A few Thursdays)

January 2nd - March 10th

- 7 registered for LTP ranging from 3-11
- LTP jerseys ordered through the arena with AMB signs doing the logos.
- LTP equipment- Buy gear as an association and keep it as an association. Charge \$80 to LTP families for set up. Once they are done, turn gear back and receive \$40 cash back and \$40 towards the PCIA shop. Net zero for players that continue on. \$169 sets normally, \$125 plus helmets and sticks. May have a sponsor- Moosehead Marina and Matt will take care of the transaction. 29 sets of different sizes available for \$6,380 total cost for equipment. This would be a start up for the exchange program. MEHA has LTP equipment reimbursement at \$1000 to use towards costs. \$1000 Maine Savings donated with no funds restricted. Once we have approval and confirmation from Mark/sponsor then the association will buy. Board approved.
