

Rhineland Ice Association Hockey - COVID 19 Policies

General Information:

STAY HOME WHEN SICK OR IF DIRECTLY EXPOSED TO COVID-19.

DO NOT COME TO PRACTICE OR A GAME IF YOU HAVE ANY COVID-19 SYMPTOMS OR OTHER ILLNESS.

DO NOT COME TO PRACTICE OR A GAME IF YOU HAVE HAD CLOSE CONTACT WITH ANYONE CONFIRMED WITH COVID-19 WITHIN THE PAST 2 WEEKS.

DO NOT COME TO PRACTICE OR A GAME IF YOU HAVE A 100.4 FEVER OR HIGHER (EVEN IF YOU HAVE NO OTHER SYMPTOMS).

PLEASE SELF MONITOR YOUR FAMILY FOR ILLNESS AND/OR SYMPTOMS.

Participation in any Rhineland Ice Association On-Ice or Off-ice activity by you or your child constitutes agreement of this document, the below risks, and the below rules. You (parent) and any participants must (1) comply with the COVID-19 policy, (2) Assume all risks of transmission and complications of COVID-19, and (3) Release and hold harmless the Rhineland Ice Association and its home ice facilities from all liability and losses arising from your participation and your child's participation in activities organized, hosted, sponsored or participated in by Rhineland Ice Association. Furthermore, you understand no refunds will be issued due to quarantine requirements, or if a team has to cancel games due to not having enough players to participate for any reason.

RULES as of 1/19/21

1. All entrants (spectators, minor officials, players, volunteers) into the rink will be required to wear masks at all times.

2. Entrance for players and spectators will be the main south entrance door (left door when entering). Spectators for games shall exit the same main entrance doors (left door when exiting). Players shall exit will be the west concession doors.

3. Skaters must bring their own water bottles.

4. Parents are required to keep players who are sick at home. Coaches will have the authority to send kids home if the child comes to the rink with symptoms of illness. Anyone with signs or symptoms of illness must not enter the facility. Parents must notify the Rink Manager of any positive tests in a player's household.

5. **GAME POLICY FOR LOCKER ROOMS:** Each team will be assigned 1 locker room, if you prefer to have room to social distance, please dress in two shifts. Masks must be worn at all times including while playing. **Entry into the rink is allowed 30 minutes before game time for players.** Locker Rooms will be sanitized between groups. **Players must leave the rink within 15 minutes of the game end.**

6. **PARENT / SPECTATOR POLICIES FOR GAMES** - Each player will be allowed four spectators per game. All spectators must wear masks at all times. Any/all spectators will not be allowed to enter the rink until game time, and will be asked to immediately go to the bleachers. Spectators/parents will be asked to leave the arena immediately following the conclusion of the game. Spectators should not go into the lobby area, unless using the restroom on an emergency basis. When games are back to back, it is expected that spectators leave the building during the break time between games. If children are one/some of the four spectators, please make sure they are following the same rules and not entering lobby, etc. Spectators should social distance in the bleachers. The concession stand will remain closed at this time.

7. **MINOR OFFICIALS** - All minor officials must wear masks. Minor officials may enter the building 10 minutes before game time to get things setup. **RIA is asking visiting team to provide their own penalty box worker to reduce the risk of our volunteers.**

7. **RESTROOMS** - Although the main lobby restrooms will be available, we ask that they only be used on an emergency basis.
