- May enter the main High School entrance or the Activity Center entrance. Matches will be played in the Main High School Gym and three courts in our Activity Center
- **Warm up balls are NOT provided**
- Concessions will be available- CASH or VENMO only
- Admission for Adults = \$8.00. Children and Seniors are \$5 CASH or VENMO only
- No outside coolers allowed. Please keep food/drink outside of the gym.
- No athletic trainer is on site see tournament director for ice and first aid
- Parking in main front lot and lower level lot

Warm Up:

- 10 minutes: 2-4-4 format
 - 2 min shared, 4 min on net including serving, serving team has net first
 - Only for match 1 and 2
- Remaining matches warm-ups will be:
 - 5 minutes: 1-2-2 format
 - 1min shared, 2 minutes on net including serving time

Officiating

- Laker JO is Providing an R1 (14's and 15's player) for all matches
- Each team will provide up to two players to keep score at the score table, one to flip, one keeping the scorebook. Please limit other players at the table.
- 11/12's serving guidelines:
 - Players are encouraged to stay behind the endline, but may move anywhere between the endline and the pre-marked 7' line. Please do not use the shorter line as an unfair advantage if the player is capable of serving from further back.
 - As a general rule, if the ball travels to within 10 feet of the opponent's endline, the server should move back at the next serving opportunity
 - The officiating coach can direct a server to move back
 - There is a maximum of 5 consecutive serves per player, at which time the team will retain the serve, but must rotate.

Pool Play

- **Warm up balls are NOT provided**
- Pool play is 2 games to 25 (no cap)
- If the two teams split their sets the team with the most favorable point differential will be awarded the match.
- If the two teams split their sets and the scores of the sets result in a 0 point differential, an additional point will be played at the end of the second game.

Bracket Play:

All 1st and 2nd place teams will advance to the gold bracket. All 3rd and 4th place teams will advance to the silver bracket
Division/Seed breakdown and placement in playoffs will be decided by:

- 1) Sets won/loss in pool
- 2) Head to Head

3) H-to-H point differential

4) Overall Point Differential

5) Coin Flip

- Format: Playoff matches are best of 3 games, the first 2 games to 25 no cap and the 3rd (if needed) to 15 with no cap
- T-Shirts for first in Gold Brackets
