Old Business:

Sport Updates:

Traveling Baseball 9U-15U: League play going on. Some teams have qualified for state tournaments. 13A had an issue at the Eagan tournament. "Bad" calls went against Hastings team. Some parents got out of line. Umpire disqualified team from the game and, unbeknownst to the team, the rest of the tournament. Tony Kaiser asked the tournament director for future games they do not get the same umpire. Saturday afternoon the team gets to the field and the same umpire is there. That's when the team finds out they were disqualified from the rest of the tournament. Tony Kaiser contacts the tournament director and MBL tournament director asking for leniency for the kids to play, but is denied. Ryan received a call from the Eagan tournament director apologizing for the umpires actions and said they would refund the team \$100. Eagan also said they would not employ that umpire in the future. Ryan to reach out to Tony and the parents who were out of line. Those parents are not to attend the next two games and issue an apology for their actions. Both Hastings hosted tournaments are all set to go. At 14/15A, two teams dropped out, but were replaced by two on the waiting list.

VFW & Legion: Parent/player meeting went well. Three players were added after the meeting. Logan Radke and Payton Neuville are the head coaches.

Traveling Softball: 10U B team "not winning." Parent blaming coaches. Team has just played tough teams.
