



FHE STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

(revised May 31, 2024)

I, _____, agree to abide by the following code of conduct when attending all FHE Student Events: (Please initial each statement)

- _____ Honor and respect adult leaders.
- _____ Show respect and kindness through my words and actions to all students at the event.
- _____ Respect the property of all participants.
- _____ Respect the property and rules of the hosting facility.
- _____ Wear modest and appropriate attire at all times.
- _____ Abide by the FHE Music Policy. (FHE Athletic Handbook section XIV)

I, _____, agree to refrain from the following at all FHE-sponsored events and on social media: (Please initial each statement)

- _____ Using profanity, saying offensive comments, making offensive gestures, or using hurtful language toward others.
- _____ Possessing or using any type of alcohol and other illegal drugs.
- _____ Possessing or using any kind of tobacco products including smoking cigarettes, chewing tobacco, using vapes, and/or juuls.
- _____ Carrying a weapon (real or toy) including guns and knives, other than is applicable and necessary for the event. (Examples: Airsoft &/or paintball guns, or Renaissance swords.)
- _____ Engaging in threats, bullying, including via social media and electronic communications, or physical altercations with others.
- _____ Any public display of affection including kissing, excessive touching, or any sexual activity.
- _____ Using FHE name or logo in personal social media accounts.
- _____ Using FHE name or logo to create a team or activity account.
- _____ Posting anything negative, derogatory, or use of foul language against FHE members or leadership, athletes, coaches, and other teams or parents.
- _____ Playing any music with foul lyrics, inferences, or euphemisms, including clean edits.

All violations of this code of conduct will be recorded by the FHE leadership and will result in the following disciplinary actions:

1. All offenses will be reported to the offender's parents or guardians.
2. Offenses are cumulative throughout the school year.
3. If an offense involves an illegal activity the proper authorities will be notified.
4. The first offense will result in a verbal warning to the offender.
5. The second offense will result in the offender being asked to leave the event and/or will be removed until a parent or guardian arrives. In the case of FHE sports, an athlete may be required not to participate in one or more events.
6. The third offense will result in a parent being required at all subsequent student events. In the case of FHE sports, an athlete may be removed from a team without a refund.
7. The fourth offense will result in the offender no longer being able to attend student events for the rest of the membership year.
8. The FHE Board reserves the right to modify the penalties in special circumstances.
