1. Register or Log Into Demosphere:

2. Select Players Birth year & Season option (see options below)
3. Select full payment or split payment (2nd installment due February 1st) & process payment.
4. July 1st—registered players will receive a link to order Uniforms from Stephens Sports. Order ASAP so your players have them in time for the Fall Season.
5. August—You will receive an introductory email from your coach and/or your team manager with practice and tournament details.

### *2019 Cranberry Clash*

Our home tournament is just a few short weeks away (June 29-30, 2019)! Everything is shaping up to make this an exciting tournament with a bit of a cranberry twist! Please read the following information reminding you of your family's volunteer obligations for the tournament. A link to sign up for shifts be emailed out around June 14th. Thank you for your help in making our tournament the best it can be!

#### **Tournament Hours:**

Each family is responsible for 4 volunteer hours per Kicker player.

1. A minimum of four (4) hours and possibly up to (6) hours of tournament volunteer hours per each registered player must be fulfilled during the weekend of the tournament. The hours are based on the hours needed to run a successful tournament. Families with more than three (3) registered players will only be required to work twelve (12) hours the weekend of the tournament.
2. Families that are unable to fulfill their required hours the weekend of the tournament, please email the Tournament Directors at [cranberryclash@gmail.com](mailto:cranberryclash@gmail.com) prior to the tournament weekend for alternative work options. (Families who do not fulfill their volunteer work requirements during a season will be assessed a fee of \$50.00 per hour not served, and will be required to pay this assessment prior to November 1 of the same year.)
3. Coaches and Assistant Coaches fulfill their tournament and non-tournament family work hours as a function of performing their coaching services throughout the season and at tournaments.
4. Managers are able to subtract 2 hours from their total required tournament hours. Thanks for all you do!
