



BRAMPTON MINOR LACROSSE ASSOCIATION INJURY POLICY 2023

“Organization or Association” refers to: Brampton Minor Lacrosse Association

ARTICLE I GENERAL

- 1.1 Any injuries occurring to an Association Member, player or bench personnel which results in them requiring medical attention beyond First Aid as a result of an injury sustained during a game or practice shall be immediately reported to the Representative, Field or Houseleague Coordinators.
- 1.2 The Representative, Field or Houseleague Division Coordinators are responsible for obtaining the necessary insurance claim forms and providing them to the injured member of the Association as appropriate. The insurance claim shall be processed directly by the member without delay.
- 1.3 No player sustaining a serious head injury, or for which unconsciousness has resulted during play or practice, shall be allowed to play without a note of consent from a physician.
- 1.4 At the discretion of the coaching staff and training of the team, consent from a physician may be requested in order to clear the Association member to participate in any game, practice or physical activity of the Association.
