



## Jersey Shore Arena – Game Restrictions / Guidelines

- 1) Temperature checks will be administered to all entering the building.
- 2) Masks must be worn at all times throughout the facility. Masks may be removed by the players entering the ice surface. Coaches, score keepers, clock and penalty box attendants must also wear masks.
- 3) Locker rooms are not available at this time.
- 4) Players should be fully dressed before entering the building. Where possible, we recommend skate guards to be worn from car to the building.
- 5) Goalies are permitted to bring bags / gear into the building and finish dressing in a public area of the lobby.
- 6) Hockey bags are **not permitted** inside the building. Players are permitted small sling bags for water, mask, skate guards, snack etc. Water bottles must have players names on the bottles – no shared water bottle usage.
- 7) Teams may enter the facility 15 minutes prior to the game start time only.
- 8) All Home & Away Teams will be checked in upon entering the building. Each team may have 1-2 volunteers to record and stream the game to their respective teams.
  - **Wildcats Teams:** Team volunteer(s), event staff, and player must complete the one-time Waiver of Liability kept on file with the Jersey Shore Arena. The Team Roster with name of accompanying event staff and volunteers must be submitted to rink no less than 48 hours prior to the game (please email to Jessica - [jessica@jerseyshorearena.com](mailto:jessica@jerseyshorearena.com) and Maggie – [Maggie@jerseyshorearena.com](mailto:Maggie@jerseyshorearena.com))
  - **Visiting Teams:** Team Roster with name of accompanying team volunteer(s) must be submitted to rink no less than 48 hours prior to the game. Visiting Teams must submit this information to the corresponding [Wildcats Team manager](#), who will provide to Jersey Shore Arena. [Waivers](#) on the Jersey Shore Arena website must be completed in advance for the respective age group.
- 9) There will be no handshake line at the conclusion of the game. In accordance with NJYHL rules and AAHA Return to Play mandate, at the end of the game, both teams will line up on their blue lines and perform a stick salute.
- 10) Players, coaches, and volunteers in the building must be respectful of social distancing requirements and adhere to rink personnel directives.
- 11) Exit the rink immediately following their game – please note if playing in Red Rink exit through the marked double doors near the CBA Locker room in Red Rink.
