

# STUDENT ID

Q: What is the Student ID submissions process?

A: All high school players are required to submit a valid student ID through the designated online jotform. The link to the jotform is located in the player registration page and is also in the REGISTRATION dropdown.

Q: Why is student ID required?

A: Student ID is required to validate that the player is a currently enrolled, full-time HS student in OR/WA.

Q: What elements constitute valid student ID?

A: School name, School year, School issued photo

Q: What is the easiest and most common document to submit to fulfill the student ID requirement?

A: Current year school-issued Student ID

Q: What if the student does not have a school-issued Student ID?

A: If a student ID is not available, screen shot(s) of school app (often called "Pinnacle") can be submitted but must contain the same elements as listed above under What constitutes a valid student ID (submit multiple photos as needed).

Q: What if the student doesn't have either of the above options?

A: the player can get a validated schedule of classes or letter from school administration. This document must contain the same elements as listed above under What constitutes a valid student ID (photo ID if possible).

Q: What if the student is homeschooled?

A: Parent must complete Homeschool Eligibility Parent Checklist and submit to [laci@rugbyoregon.com](mailto:laci@rugbyoregon.com). Checklist can be found on the Forms and Policies page found in the COACH drop down menu on the Rugby Oregon website.

Q: What does not constitute a valid student ID?

A: The following are examples of what does not constitute a valid student ID

- Student ID from previous school year
- State issued ID
