



No Pay – No Play Policy

Players who are not in good financial standing according to registration payment terms with KCYHA or a KCYHA member Club will be removed from the ice and may not participate with their Club or any KCYHA activities or be rostered on any teams until they have met their financial obligation. Players may not participate in any evaluations, tryouts, practices, games, camps, clinics, scrimmages, until the outstanding balance is paid in full. This includes spring, summer, fall and winter leagues, camps, clinics and any other ice hockey activities.

KCYHA administration will submit a monthly report to each Club's leadership with list of players who are not meeting their payment obligations. KCYHA administration will also report if alternative payment methods or payment schedules have been arranged with the players family. KCYHA administration may request that Club's leadership help with the communication and collection process.

KCYHA administration will notify Club leadership when account is paid in full and player will be removed from Not In Good Standing List.
