

# OVERTIME PROCEDURE

**Tie Games:** If games are tied after regulation play (8-Team BRACKET FORMAT AND SUNDAY GAMES ONLY), play will continue with one 4-minute sudden death overtime period. If the game remains tied, a 5 on 5 shoot out will be used and, if needed, a sudden death shoot out will be used until a winner is determined. Timeouts can be used in the overtime period if not used in regulation play.

## **Shoot out:**

The five (5) players will be selected following the conclusion of the 4-minute sudden death overtime period. **(The five players do not have to be selected prior to the game).**

**HOME TEAM has first choice to go first or second.**

The teams will alternate shots.

If a tie remains after the 5 man shoot out, a sudden death shoot out (one shot per team) will continue with players that have **not previously shot in the first shoot out.**

The final score of the game will be one goal added to the tied score. (Goals scored during the shoot-out do not count for the total game score).

EXAMPLE:

Score after three periods	2	2
Score after 4-minute OT PERIOD	2	2
Shoot out score	4	3

**FINAL SCORE:            3            2**
