Sam Houston Texans (1-1) at Dallas Skyline Raiders (0-2)

7 p.m. Friday, Forrester Field in Dallas

THE SERIES: The Raiders lead the series, winning the only previous meeting, 49-7, last season at Wilemon Field.

LAST WEEK: Both teams are trying to rebound from losses. The Texans absorbed a 55-14 Homecoming loss to Lewisville, while Skyline lost to Dallas Bishop Dunne, 16-13. The Raiders opened their season with a 22-21 loss to South Oak Cliff.

Bowie Volunteers (2-0) at Rockwall Yellowjackets (1-1)

7:30 p.m. Friday, Rockwall's Wilkerson-Sanders Memorial Stadium

THE SERIES: Rockwall leads the series, winning the only previous meeting, 49-34 last season in Rockwall. This will be the first meeting between the Volunteers and the Yellow Jackets.

LAST WEEK: Bowie improved to 2-0 with a 40-20 win over Mansfield in the Cotton Bowl, while Rockwall pounded Rowlett, 50-7. The Yellow Jackets opened the season with a wild 66-59 loss to Highland Park.

THREE FOR ALL: Bowie is shooting for its second 3-0 start in three years. The Volunteers' loss to Rockwall prevented that from happening last year.

Juan Seguin Cougars (0-2) at Everman Bulldogs (0-2)

THE SERIES: The Bulldogs lead the series, 6-1, including two of the three meetings at Everman's Marr Stadium.

LAST WEEK: Seguin absorbed a 48-6 beating from Mansfield Summit, while Everman lost to Stephenville, 13-10. The Bulldogs dropped a 26-13 decision to Crowley to start the season.
