FDL Dual and Cross Rostering:

Definitions:

Cross Roster

Per WAHA Article 1.E: A player may not be registered with more than one (1) association, or more than one (1) team in the same age classification, unless a female player is registered on one (1) youth team and one (1) girls team at the same age level. NOTE: This will be identified as “cross-roster”. (An association that wishes to cross-roster a female player MUST complete the on-line Cross-Rostering Form on the WAHA website for approval by November 15th. Cross-roster players on a secondary team will only be eligible for State Tournament with the secondary team if the roster has 14 or less players.

Dual Roster

Any player can, however, as long as the player meets age classification, be registered with more than one team in a different age classification within the same association. NOTE: this will be identified as “double-roster”

Players cannot be included on more than two rosters per WAHA rules.

Primary Team

The team by which you have a “core” responsibility towards.

Secondary Team

The team by which skaters have a responsibility towards when there are no conflicts with their primary team.

Evaluation Process:

1. Your primary team will be determined when you register for season registration.
 - a. Skaters have until September 1st to change their selection of primary team. Any change must be communicated to the Hockey Committee Chairs, Hockey Director and Rink Manager.

2. If you wish to Cross Roster or Dual Roster skaters must select and pay in full at season registration.
 - a. Skaters have until September 1st to change their selection of Cross Roster or Dual Roster. Any change must be communicated to the Hockey Committee Chairs, Hockey Director and Rink Manager.
3. Girls that wish to cross-roster OR dual-roster will be ranked based on the scores achieved during their age level evaluation process. Boys that wish to Dual-roster will be ranked based on the scores achieved during their age level evaluation process.
4. Coaches will be asked after tryouts if they want to cross-roster and/or dual roster. Coaches will have to pick the recommended amount of players at tryouts for their team. Dual-rostering and/or cross-rostering will be for supplementation purposes only.
5. Only 2nd year players at their age specific level will be allowed to Dual-roster.
 - a. Coed Mite to Squirt Thunder & U8 to U10 Warbirds Dual Rosteing. You have to be a 2nd year Mite to be able to Dual-roster and they will only be able to play at the lowest level team at Squirts and U10.
6. The head coach has the decision to accept Cross-Rostering and/or Dual-rostering, but players will be assigned based on the evaluation process ranking. **Example: If a coach wants to Dual-roster and/or Cross-Roster 3 players, we will give the coach the three top girls and the three top boys and they will be able to choose which three players they want to take. When they decide which players they want to take we will ask the parents if the player accepts.**
7. We will accept cross-rostering girls from other coed organizations.

Season Guidelines

1. If a player states their intention to cross-roster or dual-roster, they must determine their “primary” team at registration.
2. The “primary” team is the team that takes priority if there are any practice or game conflicts unless agreed to by both team coaches.
3. Players will be able to practice with their secondary team 5 times throughout the season. If your secondary team makes the state tournament the player will be able to practice as much as they want with their secondary team.

4. Players will be allowed to play 10 games throughout the regular season. Tournament weekend will count as 2 games.
5. Cannot play more than two games in a day and no more than five games in a weekend.
6. Out of organization players will pay \$350 of our organization fees and skaters within the Blue Line organization will pay \$250 at registration. Fees are fully refundable if skaters are not selected for Cross Roster or Dual Roster.

Fond du Lac Blue Line Exceptions

1. **The Fond du Lac Blue Line Hockey Committee Chairs and Fond du Lac Board President reserve the right to amend, change, adapt, or delete any Cross Roster or Dual Roster rule for the betterment of a team or skater.**
