



RMR SPECTATOR/PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT 25-26

Entry to this *privately sanctioned* event is granted as a courtesy.

By entering the event premises, ***you agree to abide by the following code of conduct guidelines:***

I WILL:

- Abide by the official rules of USA Volleyball.
- Honor the rules of the host and the host facility.
- Display good sportsmanship at all times.
- Behave respectfully towards all match officials and support staff at all times.
- Encourage my child, his/her team, and the opponents, regardless of the outcome on the court.
- Acknowledge effort and good performance, remembering that all of the players in this event are amateur athletes.
- Generate goodwill by being polite and respectful to those around me at this event.
- Direct my child to speak directly with his/her coach when decisions are made that may be confusing or unclear.
- Direct all concerns regarding officiating to the RMR directly, by using the RMR "COPS" form
 - *It is inappropriate for participants to make complaints on-site to event coordinators or officials directly*
- Support the policies and guidelines of the team/club that I represent.
- Follow all state, local and facility regulations regarding possession or use of alcohol or other controlled substances
- Immediately notify the Event Director or RMR staff in the event that I witness any illegal or inappropriate activity.
- Model exemplary spectator behavior while attending this event.
 - ***Especially, I will carry out or properly dispose of all trash that my team brings on site!***

I WILL NOT:

- Harass or intimidate the officials or other match participants at any time
- Coach my child from the bleachers and/or sidelines.
- Criticize my child's coach or his/her teammates.
- Participate in sanctioned activities unless I am a registered member of USAV/RMR, and rostered with a team.
- Possess or carry Firearms or Deadly Weapons onto any RMR-sanctioned facility premises
- Bring personal alcoholic beverages onto any RMR event site, violate local alcohol ordinances or become publicly intoxicated.

Note: Persons who violate this Code of Conduct may be sanctioned by, among other actions, removal from premises, monetary fines, and/or loss of access to future RMR events. Fines may be assessed to Clubs to whom violators are affiliated. Multiple violations of this policy may be escalated to the RMR Ethics and/or Juniors Committees for further consideration and/or sanction.
