



The Wisconsin Adaptive Sports Association (WASA) is seeking help for the 2021-22 season to fund our eight adaptive sport programs. WASA is the first organization of its kind to offer a wide array of adaptive sports in the state of Wisconsin.

The estimated cost per athlete to participate in their program is up to \$3,500 each year depending on their sport. With your help, WASA will continue to provide a safe and fun environment for youth and adults with disabilities to make new friends, exchange ideas, and develop positive attributes, such as goal setting, teamwork and responsibility. The programs aim to aid disabled community members towards wellness, an independent life, and to help provide important life skills.

The WASA 400 Challenge is a fundraising event where all WASA athletes are challenged to complete as many laps/miles as possible in a 2 hour time frame. WASA volunteers/community members will also have the opportunity to participate by walking/wheelchair/wear eyeshades and seeing how far they can go. The event will take place on August 15 from 5pm to 7pm at Lomira High School track or virtually for those not in the event area.
