1. Financial Information - Wayne Vance, League Treasurer, presented the financial information from the 2018 season and a proposed budget for 2019. For more details contact Wayne.
2. Intro of Board - An opening for 22+ Division Representative was discussed. Tim Biggs of the 22+ Chesapeake Hooks volunteered for the position. He was approved by unanimous league vote.
3. Website - League presented that they were working to set up a new website to streamline and automate some of the process. League has contacted SportsEngine and hopes to have online registration set up.
4. Tournaments - Barry Jurich, Tournament Director, presented that the league would be bringing back the Columbus Day Tournament. October 11-14. League is finalizing fees and roles. Possible for discounts for early registration.
 - a. Charlottesville MSBL contacted the league to gather interest in a Labor Day tournament
5. Orioles Tickets - Fundraiser was discussed using the Orioles tickets as done in previous years. Each ticket is \$15, with the league receiving \$1 and the team getting \$4 for every ticket sold. The new website could be used for advertising.
6. Fields - League submitted permits for all fields available. It is anticipated that we would receive Annapolis, Arundel, North East, Old Mill and Ft Meade, in addition to Generals Highway, Sawmill, Cannon and Bachman. The possibility of games on Monday's and Friday's were mentioned given field availability.
 - a. The county is looking to turf the infield through donations through the casino. In order to obtain lights at Bestgate the possibility of using Bestgate on weeknights was mentioned. The league also requested Bell Branch.
 - b. There was a previous disconnect at Annapolis between the AD and field maintenance. Field will have regular maintenance by the Annapolis crew. League also has a trailer to transport supplies in order to maintain the field.
7. Supplies - Danny Tyler, Field Director is looking to inventory container at Bestgate and refresh supplies. He will be ordering clay bricks for Arundel, Bestgate and Glen Burnie. Also looking into dirt for Bestgate and North East. Bags of clay for Annapolis.
8. Draft - Tryout and Draft will be held at March 2 at BASES. The 35 and 45 tryouts will be from 8:45-9:30. The 22 tryouts from 9:45 to 10:30. Drafts held immediately after.
9. Divisions - Divisions would be depending on number of teams
10. Donations - League is currently soliciting donations for organizations outside of Wounded Warrior Softball team.
11. Paperwork - Deposits of \$500 due before March 1. Remaining balance due April 1. Paperwork will be electronic, however teams will have to sign County Roster.
12. All Star game - League needs to confirm details.
13. Trophies and T shirts - will be handed out at next meeting
14. Hall of Fame - It was announced that Jeff Pate of the Chesapeake Braves, and Ron Ebelein of the Chesapeake White Sox were elected to the Hall of Fame.
15. Manager Q and A:

- a. Umpire Fees? Same as last year
- b. Number of games? 20-25
- c. Proposed 35 and 45 Crossover? No interest in doing so
- d. Baseballs? To be delivered on 4/29, getting baseballs from Diamond. ½ Doz will be provided to teams that need them until new balls come in.
- e. Players not affiliated with MSBL for tournaments? They would pay a \$40 MSBL fee and fill out all required forms.
- f. When would playoffs start? Pending number of games and field allocations. Normally mid August. Opening Day is April 28.
- g. Rainouts? Hope is extra nights from the county and using 4pm Sunday's and possibly Saturdays for make ups.
- h. Can ASG be moved up? Prime field such as Frederick Keys Stadium would not be available.
