Rule changes 2017

- Instead of a 6 inch layer of tape for faceoffs, it can be paint. It can run up to but cannot cover the head
- Defensive players playing goalie – stepping into the cage to stop a shot will result in a whistle unless a shot is in the air. 1st: conduct foul 2nd: releasable conduct foul (1 min)
- Last 2 minutes of the game, if there is a goal differential of 4 goals or less they will get a stall warning. 5 or more goals – no stall warning
- Mouth guards now a technical foul. Referees will be calling it. No fish hooking
- Faceoffs: pre whistle violation the ball will be awarded in the offensive ½ of the field
- POINTS OF EMPHASIS
 - Coaches staying in the team area
 - Special awareness of blindside hits or defenseless hits
 - 2018 – same head structure on the sticks as in college
