Job Description

Bus Driver

Job Brief

The bus driver is responsible for safely transporting NLYHA players back and forth between the Breezy Point Ice Arena and the Hallett Community Center in Crosby. Additional pick-up locations such as the Pequot Lakes Middle School may also be used. The bus not only carries players, but also equipment such as sticks and hockey bags that may be clunky. Bus drivers may need to assist players with their equipment. Bus drivers will be transporting both boys and girls and may have up to 14 players on the bus at a time.

Primary Statement of Duties

- Safely navigate buses provided by NLYHA.
- Bus shifts are typically on Mondays, Tuesdays and Thursdays beginning at 3:00 pm and ending around 10:30 pm. This schedule begins October 21, 2019 and runs through roughly mid to late February 2020.
- Bus shifts and routes are based on the ice schedule.
- A discipline process exists for any behavior issues with players.

- Excellent communication skills
- You like to work with or being around kids
- Dispute settlement
- Flexible work hours
- Cellular phone and voice mail capability
- Must register as a volunteer with USA Hockey and NLYHA, then complete an online background check and online Safesport Training prior to starting. NLYHA will reimburse for all applicable fees related to this required.

NLYHA Provides

- The drivers will report to the Ice and Game Scheduler.
- Ice schedules will be made available at least two weeks in advance.
- Position is paid every 2 weeks and is a formal employee of Northern Lakes Youth Hockey Association. This position pays \$15.00 per hour.
