In an organized essay of 400-500 words, respond to any one of the following prompts below. ***Please note, each are meant as starting points, not cages; you do not need to address all areas.*

1. What does it mean to have passion, enthusiasm, and love for the game of hockey? How is it reflected in your life, both on and off the ice? Is it something that has always been present for you?
2. Frederick Douglass believed that “[w]ithout a struggle, there can be no progress.” Have there been moments in your life, or areas in your game, where you have had to embrace struggle in order to improve? How does or how has your hard work and your discipline defined who you are to this point and who you will be in the future?
3. Give an example of someone or something that defines “sportsmanship” for you. When you think of “integrity or respect for the game”, why does this example come to mind/why does it resonate for you? Why is sportsmanship important? Are there times where others might say you’ve demonstrated these traits for them?
