Meeting called to order at 8 pm

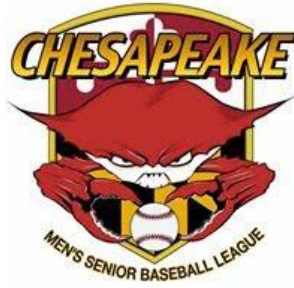
Managers Page - The location of the managers page on the website was shown to everyone and how to access it. Information on this page includes lockbox combinations, umpire review forms, and field maintenance information.

Field Permits - The league is waiting on final permits to be issued. Practice times at Bestgate Park are full and the league is waiting on Generals Highway dates in order to allow teams to practice.

Final Balances for league fees are due April 16.

Umpire Evaluations - Alex Brunet explained that umpire reviews are strongly encouraged to provide feedback to AAUA. They are used to weed out under performing umpires.

Website - The league website has been updated with rule changes for the 2022 season. Also, the website will be used in certain instances to send league wide emails to every player.



Capital Expenditures- Turf renovations at Joe Cannon will not be completed until May/June timeframe and the completion of the lights at Bestgate has been delayed as well. The league is exploring the possibility of locking Generals Highway. The league is looking to purchase a container and a tractor to use at GH. The league is also looking to contribute to a batting cage at Annapolis HS. Alex Brunet has talked to a local turf company to donate used turf to the league as we are a non-profit. The league is looking into leveling and resod Bestgate park for drainage.

A question was asked regarding metal cleats allowed at Joe Cannon. This was not known at the time of the meeting and would be reported to all league members once the county notified the board.
