- League makeup games
 - Coach Pitch and Junior League games can be scheduled on Wed. next week (7/14).
 - League Commissioners can/should work with Jamie to determine what leagues/games must be rescheduled diamond availability is very limited.
- League Tournament
 - Brackets will be updated and resent tomorrow. Some softball games will be moved to Hortonville.
 - Thursday: games stay the same.
 - Friday: 7 games in Greenville and 7 games in Hortonville
 - Saturday: Schedule remains the same. All semi-finals and Finals will be played in Greenville on Saturday.
 - Tournament games will play and abide by the same rules as used all season and as published on the GYS website.
 - No game shall end in a tie. Games that have a tie score when time expires shall play additional innings with the International Tie Breaker rule in effect. ITB Rule – Offense begins with a runner at second (runner is last out from prior inning), no outs.

 - There continues to be discussion of combining GYS and HYS. The girls program is looking at establishing a 501(c)3 under the name of Polar Bear Youth Sports. If/when we combine the thought is that we could combine under this new organization and GYS and HYS would dissolve as organization. Goal/discussion is to get to this position by 2023.
