Travel:

Mike will take care of brackets with MYAS. The day of the tournament, he will have all tournament related items (coaches signup, wall brackets, tournament grid, binders with all game sheets, online access to update games, etc). He has also secured the Refs.

The one thing Mike will need help with is on Sunday of the tournament distributing awards. Most will be upstairs in the cafeteria but medals will handed out at the courts again this year. Ryan will help with this.

Games will be running every hour, to help with this all 4th, 5th and C bracket games will be running time.

New rules incorporating the MYAS recommendations for 2019. Mike was a part of a tournament director survey regarding 4th grade and the new MYAS rules. It sounds like most if not all tournaments are adopting these

recommendations. Mike has organized the Rules page a little more so hopefully it is a little more understandable. He will have a Rules sheet in every binder at every scorer's table.

Can someone add this Rules sheet to our website as soon as possible: Jim is taking care of this.

I want to make sure everyone who looks at it between now and the tournament have the correct rules sheet out there.

Also, when taping the floors, we will need to mark each floor with a small 12 foot line for free throws for 4th grade. I would just make it in the center of the lane about a foot wide.

Hamre will set up sign genius (hourly). Bridget and Kerry will get the shifts needed. Thursday unloading of concessions, Friday taping of floors.

NEW RULES:

STMA Girls Basketball Tournament Rules

Each team will be permitted to have TWO COACHES admitted free per game. Coaches will sign/check in at each site they play in.

1. Minnesota High School rules will apply except as noted below.
2. NOTE: STMA is adopting the recommendation from MYAS for 4th Grade Brackets.
 - a. Ball size – 27.5 sized ball
 - b. Free throws – shoot from 12 feet
 - c. Pressing – only during last 2 minutes of each half.
 - d. Zones – no zones allowed
 - e. Game time – 20 minute halves, running time. Last 2 minutes of each half will be stop time.
3. 5 th Grade Brackets
 - a. Ball size – regulation size, 28.5 sized ball
 - b. Free throws – regulation length
 - c. Pressing – Only allowed in 2nd half
 - d. Zones – no zones allowed
 - e. Game time – 20 minute halves, running time. Last 2 minutes of each half will be stop time.
4. 6 th -8 th Grade Brackets
 - a. All Minnesota State High School rules apply
5. All "C" Brackets (including 6 th -8 th Grade)
 - a. Game time - All "C" Brackets will be 20 minute running time halves. Last 2 minutes of each half will be stop time.
 - b. All other Minnesota High School rules apply
6. All games will consist of two halves. There will be a three minute break at half time.
7. Each team is allowed 3 time-outs per game. Each team is permitted one time out per each overtime period.
8. First Overtime will be two-minute stop time. Second Overtime will be first team to score.
9. Attendance is required 15 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time. At least 3 minutes will be allowed for warm-up. Team line-ups must be logged in the official score book five minutes before the start of the game. If an incorrect line-up is entered on the official score sheet, the bench will receive a technical foul. Games will start early when possible.
10. A team cannot start a game with less than 5 players. If enough players are not on the floor 5 minutes after the scheduled start time, the game is forfeit. The score for a forfeit will be 15-0.
11. Bonus (one-and-one) free throws will be shot on the 7 th foul per half. Double bonus on the 10 th foul at which time 2 shots are awarded
12. If a team receives a technical foul, the opposing team will be awarded 2 points and possession of the ball.
13. A fifth foul will result in player disqualification from the game.

14. No presses are permitted by a team with more than a 20-point lead. After the first warning, the penalty for each violation of this rule will be a technical foul.
15. The three point shot is in effect on all courts.
16. Play will be running time in the second half if the lead is 20 points or more. Stop time will resume if lead is cut to 10 points or less.
17. Pool Play Tie Breaker will be determined by head to head competition if a two way tie. If more than two teams are tied or the teams didn't play each other, First tiebreaker: Total point differential (total points scored - total points allowed). Second tiebreaker: Total points scored - all 3 games. The 3rd tiebreaker is a coin flip.
18. No protest will be considered. All decision by officials and scorekeepers/timers are final.
19. Players, coaches and fans must follow good sportsmanship rules. Inappropriate actions and/or words by coaches, fans and players will not be tolerated. The first time a warning will be given. The second time the person will be asked by the tournament's gym supervisor to leave the gym. The game will be stopped until the person leaves. If they have not left within 5 minutes the game will be called and the coach's, player's or fan's team will forfeit. If a second offense is committed during the tournament, the person will not be allowed to attend any more games. Coaches are responsible for informing their assistant coaches, players and fans of this rule.
20. Home team is the team listed first on pool play bracket or on top in bracket play. Home team will have the choice of jersey color. Each team should have two jerseys. Home team will provide official adult scorekeeper and game ball.
