Girls Basketball Wins Holiday Tourney

The girls' basketball team captured the Wheaton North Christmas Tournament with a 52-43 victory over Bartlett in the championship game.

After losing two games by a total of three points before the tourney, the girls demonstrated their resilience by winning three close games to claim the title.

GBS won the first game easily, defeating St. Charles East 70-36.

The girls played their best game of the year and had outstanding contributions from the entire squad. Libbie Vanderveen led the way with 15 points, followed by Makayla Stadler and Eden Frick with 11, Grace O'Brien, Kristin Ralston and Challen Flaws with 7, Maddie Kapsimalis with 6, Julia DiSano with 5, and Shelby Green with 2.

Stadler led the team with 7 rebounds while Kate Gregory pulled down 6. Stadler led the team with 3 steals, while Vanderveen provided 4 assists followed by Kapsimalis and Flaws with 3 apiece. GBS shot 57% from 2 and 60% from 3 for the game.

The girls held off a scrappy Willowbrook team in the quarterfinal, winning 47-41.

Ralston led the team with 14 points, followed by Vanderveen with 13, Stadler with 8, DiSano and Flaws with 5, and Streb with 2. Vanderveen pulled down 11 rebounds while Stadler had 8 and Ralston 7. Vanderveen and Stadler continued their theivery, as they stole the ball a combined 13 times. Vanderveen had 4 assists and Stadler contributed three.

The Titans played terrific defense in the semi-final against Downers Grove North, winning 44-32.

Vanderveen scored 13, Stadler 12, Ralston 10, DiSano 5 and Streb 4 in the contest. The Titans were 14/20 from two point shots and 3 for 8 from downtown. Vanderveen led all rebounders again with 7, followed by Ralston's 5. Vanderveen and Stadler tallied three steals apiece while Stadler led the team with 7 assists and Vanderveen sharing 3. Vanderveen and Flaws teamed up to hold All-Tournament selection Ellie Gross to one basket.

The championship game was a real test for the Titans.

Early in the game, the squad lost defensive stalwart DiSano to injury and fell behind 11-2. The Titans fought back to cut the deficit to 5 by the quarter, and a terrific second quarter by Streb with ten points off the bench and two big threes by Flaws put the Titans ahead by 2 at the half, a lead they never relinquished.

The Titans played a great 3rd quarter with stellar defense and key buckets by Stadler, Streb, Flaws and Ralston, and led 39-36 going into the final stanza. Backbreaking threes by Vanderveen and Flaws and a key two point basket by Ralston gave the Titans some breathing room and Vanderveen iced it at the end with 4 straight pressure free throws to give the Titans the title with a 9 point victory over a Bartlett squad that had won 13 straight games.

Streb led the squad with 15 points, followed by Flaws with 13, Stadler with 10, Vanderveen with 9 and Ralston with 5. The terrific all-around play of Vanderveen and Stadler earned them spots on the ten-player all-tournament team.

The Titans are now 14-3 overall.



Boys Basketball Takes Fourth Place at Wheeling Hardwood Classic

The Titans went 2-2 and took fourth place in the Wheeling Hardwood Classic Holiday tournament.

The Titans opened with wins against Taft, 74-47, and Prospect, 68-39. They lost in the semifinals against Fremd, 47-44. In the third place game, they lost to St. Viator, 61-45.

Domic Martinelli and Will King both made the all-tournament team.

The Titans take on Streamwood on Jan 9, at 7 p.m., in the Titan Dome.

Varsity Jazz: Performance at 2:33 p.m.

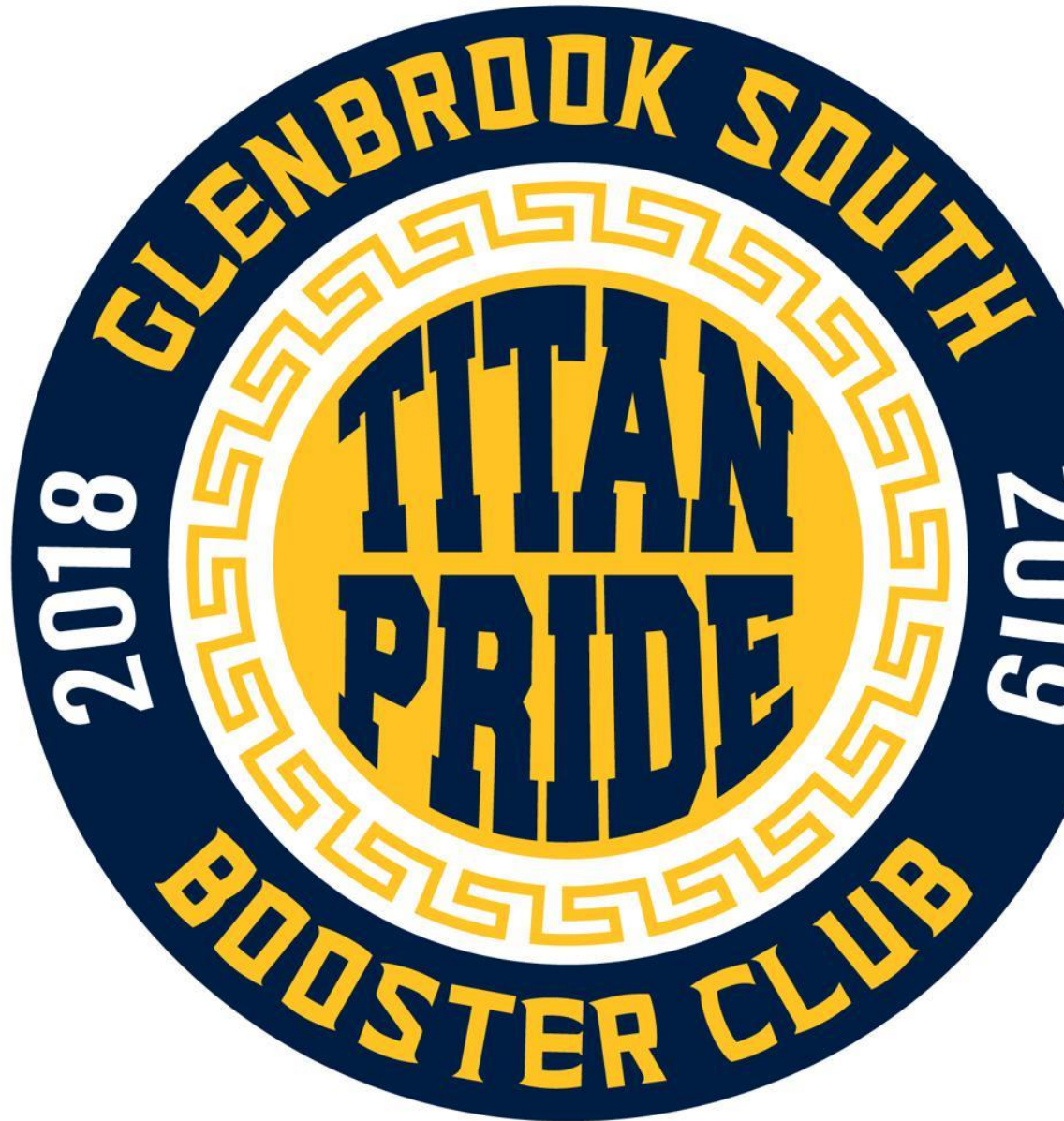
JV Pom: Performance at 5:12 p.m.

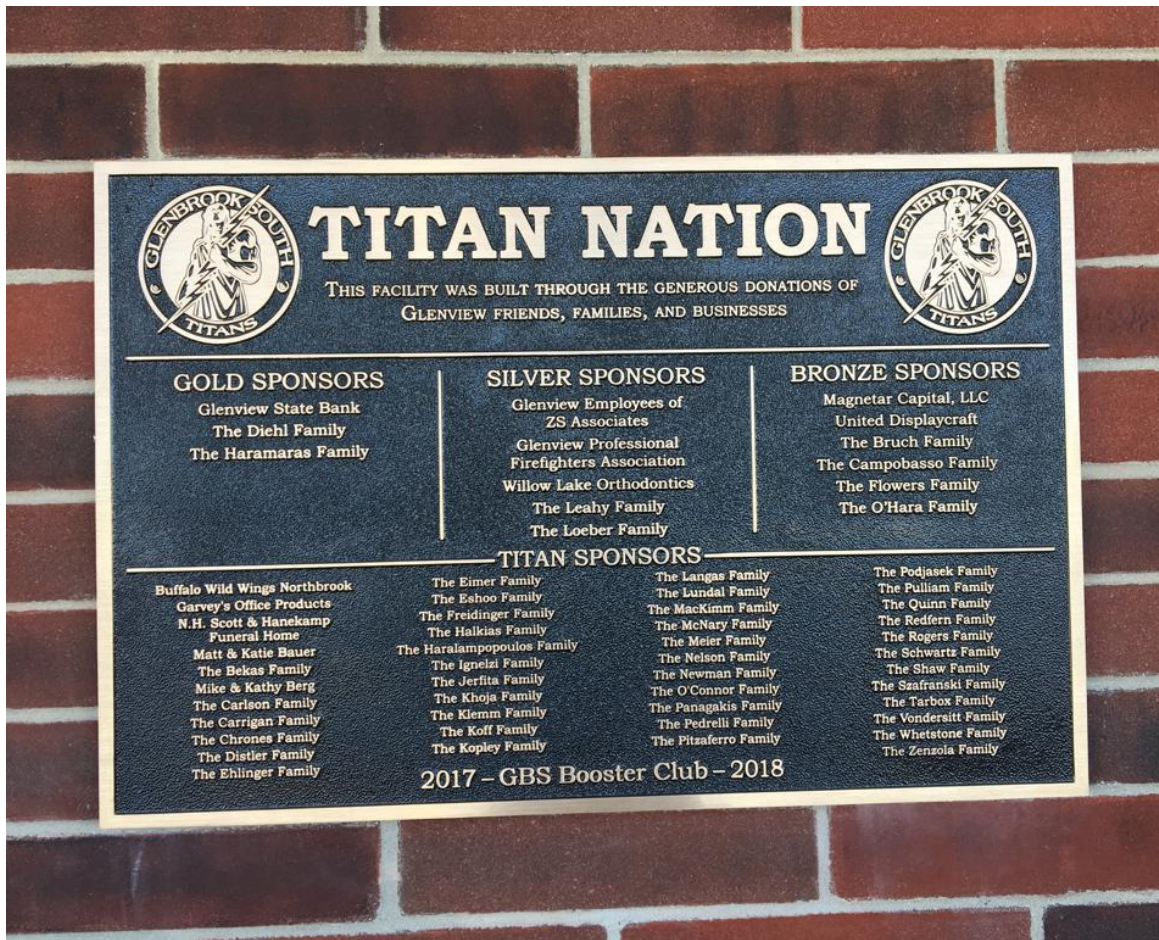
