



OKSC Weather Policy

Rain - We play rain or shine!

Thunder / Lightning - Delays or cancellations of games occur only for electrical storms, unplayable fields, significant risk of severe weather (e.g., tornado), or extremely poor weather conditions. Ultimately, the referee has the final say over delaying or restarting a match due to weather - **this will be done at the field.**

Extreme Heat - Games will carry on despite the heat. Players will be provided with additional water breaks and we recommend you bring extra water to the field for your player. It is always up to the individual family to decide whether or not to participate during hot weather.

Air Quality - We monitor air quality closely and follow the guidelines established by the Durham Region Soccer Association (DRSA). If the Air Quality Health Index (AQHI) is **6 or higher**, we will assess conditions and make a decision **prior to the start of the program**. Cancellations will be communicated to families as early as possible. As always, participation remains at the discretion of each family based on their comfort level and individual health considerations.

Games cancelled due to a field closure (prior to the game start - i.e. this is not applicable when the game is called on the field) will be added to the end of the season (**max 1 game**)

Games cancelled by the match officials due to thunder will not be added to the end of the season
