

Program Guidelines

HOCKEY PROGRAMMING (Youth)

Game Day Protocols

(Updated 01/07/2021)

- All patrons must wear a mask or face coverings at all times! (including putting on and taking off skates). Masks may only be removed when getting on the ice.
- Enter and exit the facility only using the main entrance. There are signs to enter and exit specific doors.
- Teams will not be allowed into the facility until BOTH teams are out of the facility from the game before yours. A HISC Staff member will let teams know when they are allowed into the facility. Please refrain from loitering outside the doors/on the picnic tables.
- The use of locker rooms will be unavailable. Players need to be fully dressed before entering the facility except skates, gloves, and helmet. **No hockey bags are allowed in the building.** Players may put skates on inside the facility in a designated area as described below, with markers
- Home team will walk into the facility and head straight down the hallway (hallway with bathrooms) through the double doors, and spread out on the first row of the bleachers to put their skates on.
- Away teams will walk into the facility and use the back room (by Managers' offices) and use the benches to put on skates.
- Only one parent/guardian (must reside in the same household) will be allowed in the building per skater. Exception: If one parent/guardian is a coach, the other will be allowed. No siblings allowed. One parent will be allowed in at the start of the slot and must check in with the front desk. They must leave immediately after the slot ends. No socializing or congregating in groups. Stand or sit in designated areas only.
- Only 3 coaches and one team manager may enter the facility at a time PER Team.
- All coaches, team managers, score and time keepers, must wear masks at all times.
- Only one time keeper may be in the scorekeepers' box at a time.
- Penalty boxes will not be used for teams. A player receiving a penalty will report to his/her own bench.
- Goalies will still be permitted into the facility 15 Minutes prior to their game slot, and may use a locker room that is specified to them.
- Please make sure to take any and all personal belongings off of the bench areas, as there will be no lost and found.
- Refrain from loitering or socializing inside the building.

Practice Day Protocols

(Updated 01/07/2021)

- All patrons must wear a mask or face coverings at all times! (including putting on and taking off skates). Masks can only be removed when getting on the ice.
- Only 4 Coaches and 1 Team Manager will be allowed into the facility during their teams practice.
- Only one parent/guardian will be allowed inside the facility during any practice slot/time. Parent/Guardian must sign in at the front desk when entering the facility and exit when the player's session is over.
- Goalies will be permitted into the facility 15 Minutes prior to their practice slot, and may use a locker room that is specified to them.
- The use of locker rooms will be unavailable. Players need to be fully dressed before entering the facility except skates, gloves, and helmet. **No hockey bags are allowed in the building.**
- Each team will have a designated area to put on skates. There are four areas in HISC for teams: Lobby, Balcony, Back Room (by managers' offices) and front row of the bleachers. Teams will now be allowed in 15 minutes prior to their practice start time, and must go to the designated area assigned by a HISC Staff member. HISC recommends buying skate guards to put on skates prior to entering the facility.

Entering our facility is not permitted if you have had any of the following:

- **A positive test for Covid-19, or if you are waiting for a Covid-19 test result.**
- **Close contact with someone who has a confirmed positive for Covid-19 (Being within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more, or anyone who lives in the same household)**

Please follow required quarantining measures (14 days) prior to returning to our facility.

Please keep in mind that all policies may change at any given time for any given reason. HISC is striving to provide a safe and healthy environment for all. HISC will update all patrons on any changes to these policies. We ask for full cooperation from all patrons so HISC can remain running in a healthy environment.
