**Saturday AM wave: All B18U and 2 pools of B14U.**

**PM wave: All 16U and 3 pools of B14U.**

**1)UNO Training Center-** 570 Joyce Rd., Joliet (concession stand will be open, **no outside food allowed-** cash/card accepted). Athletic trainer is available at this site. Outside chairs are allowed. Parking all around the building is allowed. Do NOT Park in truck bays, your car will be towed. Do not block area near fire hydrant for thru traffic, your car will be towed.

**2)Nowel Park Recreation Center-** 199 Mills Rd, Joliet(local pizza and items catered in-cash only concessions) Door is cash/card. Athletic trainer is available at this site. Outside chairs are allowed. Park in lot or perpendicular to Mills Road in grassy area in front of building.

**3)Joliet Catholic Academy-** 190 N. Larkin Ave., Joliet(no concessions, outside food is allowed). Door is cash/card. Athletic trainer available at this site. Outside chairs are allowed. There is plenty of parking in school lot surrounding the school, near tennis courts as well. Enter main door facing south.

**4)Troy Middle School-** 5800 Theodore St., Plainfield (no concessions, outside food is allowed). Door is cash/card. Ice and band aids will be available at this site. Plenty of bleacher seating, no outside chairs needed at this site. Plenty of parking at this school, enter Door 16 for tournament. Ice and band aids available at this site.

**Match play starts at all sites at 8AM.**

Doors will open 1 hour before first match. Lead ref provided, all teams must supply a work team.

Tie breaker System: **Head-to-Head Competition:** If two teams are tied, the head-to-head results are used to determine the winner.

- **Point Differential:** If head-to-head results are tied, the point differential is applied. The teams' point differentials are totaled, and the team with the highest sum places first.
- **Multiple Ties:** If more than two teams are tied, the point differentials of the teams involved are added, and the results recalculated.
- **Coin Toss:** If still tied after the above procedures, a coin toss is used to break the tie.
- This system ensures a fair resolution of ties in AAU competitions.
