02/20/2023 CABC Annual Meeting Minutes

David Best opens meeting at 6:05PM

- I stopped by the lower field today and they repaired the grass and put sand down to level the lower field. The damage was due to someone riding an ATV on the property. Grass has been cut so it will be ready to paint on Thursday. Also, about obtaining keys to the lower shed. (Anne indicates that she gives all coaches a light key and key to the shed. She also states she gets them back at the end of each season.)
- Congratulations to the High School Girls Track, including pandemic year, they have won the State Championship seven(7) years in a row. Boys Track has five(5) State Championships in a row.

Anne:

- Indicated that the CABC will fund the purchase of Championship Rings for the High School Coaches out of the Track Funds(Shirt funds, gate, etc.). They help out our Middle School program tremendously and do not receive a stipend for doing so. We thought it would be a nice gesture since they give us all this time. This year they need to have trouts on two(2) nights since there are two hundred sixty(260) kids trying out.
- Spring Registration closed at the end of January. The county left soccer registration open for a week after ours closed. Our coaches already have games scheduled when the fields open on 02/04/23. I have received approximately forty(40) emails in the past month regarding switching sports since they did not make the team they tried out for. We will not be letting them switch. We will not open for one and not the other so therefore registration is closed. Unless there is a very unusual circumstance for why they did not register. We had this issue in the Fall with Football. We do not feel it is fair to the families that have registered properly to allow these families to register.

- We keep FamilyID open all year so the parents get on the distribution list for all preseason workouts.

- We will be taking Coaching applications for the Fall starting the end of March.
- Scoreboard Fundraiser: Two(2) weeks away. We will have approximately one hundred twenty five(125) Baskets. We have around two hundred(200) people as of now that will be attending. We will also start the night with between twenty five(25) and thirty(30) thousand dollars before opening up the doors. We have a lot of volunteers and are also doing concessions. We have been working on mock ups of the Scoreboard. We are hoping to get it installed by Fall. Also working on Sponsorships for the Scoreboard.

- Spirit Wear has new items in the trailer. We made approximately thirty(30) thousand dollars on Spirit Wear last year. The previous Board never registered a profit according to their books.

- Rijan Robinons former Panthers Wide Receiver will be conducting Speed and Agility for the next nine(9) weeks for the Boys Middle School Lacrosse Team. The team is paying for it through fundraising money.
