

# MALONE MINOR HOCKEY

## Coach and Volunteer Training Requirements

In order to ensure a safe and productive season USA Hockey requires Coaches and Volunteers to complete certain training modules. These requirements are outlined below

**HEAD COACH** – A head coach must register with USA Hockey as a coach AND complete all training requirements (disabled clinic, online module, SafeSport and background check). We need at least one head coach per team for every 20 players rostered.

**ASSISTANT COACH** – An Assistant Coach must register with USA Hockey as a coach AND complete the online training, SafeSport and background check requirements. They are strongly encouraged but not required to attend the disabled clinic.

**ON ICE VOLUNTEER** – An on-ice volunteer must register with USA Hockey as a volunteer AND complete SafeSport and background check form if they are over 18 years of age. More information below.

**TEAM MANAGERS** – A team manager must register with USA Hockey as a volunteer AND complete the SafeSport module and background check form if they are over 18 years of age. All head coaches, assistant coaches, team managers and on ice volunteers must also complete the volunteer application on the MN Special Hockey website.

### Requirements for Volunteers

Needed: -US Hockey Volunteer Registration Number -USA Hockey Background Check -SafeSport Certification

1). USA Hockey Volunteer Number -usahockey.com

- go to become a member tab for ice manager/volunteers and register
- you will need this number for registrations

2). USA Hockey Background Check -usahockey.com

- Player and Parents tab -> Safe Sport -> scroll down to quick links for Safe Sport Training and the Background check

Rules are always changing for the frequency of how often these requirements need to be done

Background checks are now done by USA Hockey- National Screening service. All new screens done after April 1, 2020 will be valid for two seasons. The cost is \$30. You can check status if you need to it be done. If it says it does not have your social security number that means it hasn't been completed. Go back and complete the New Background Screening Registration.

3). Safe Sport -usahockey.com

- Player and Parents tab -> Safe Sport-> scroll down to quick links for training Access required core training here if new to safe sport. Or sign back into training if you have completed before- once logged in you will see what needs to be completed.
