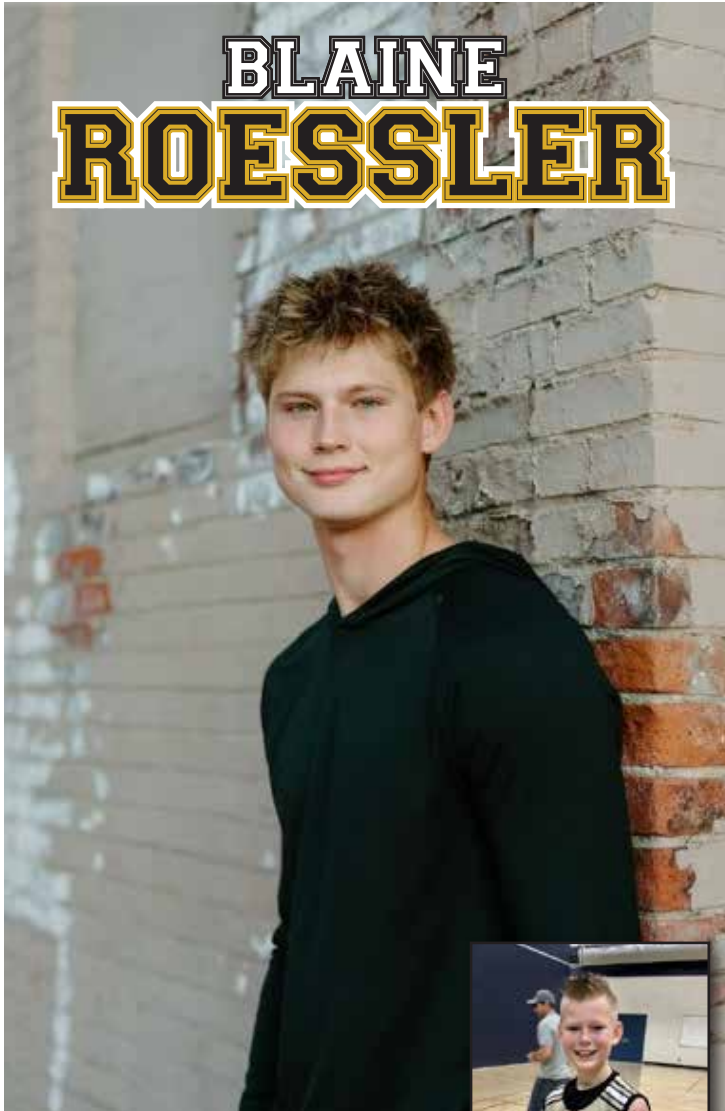

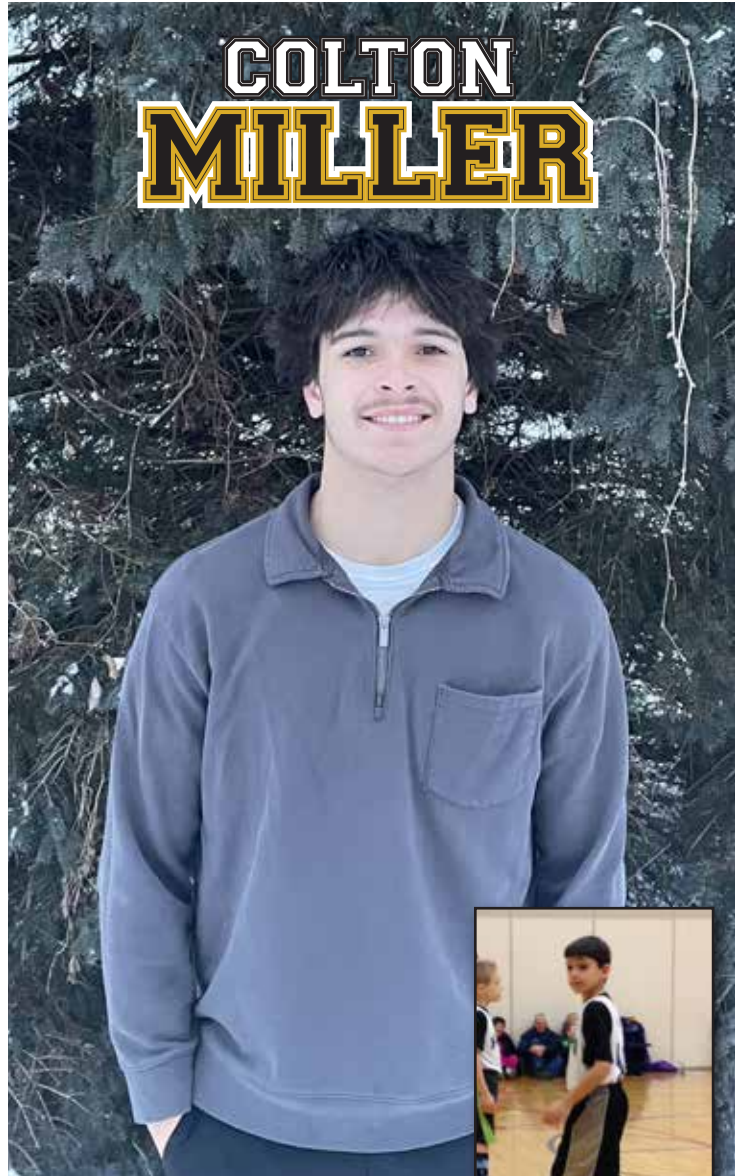

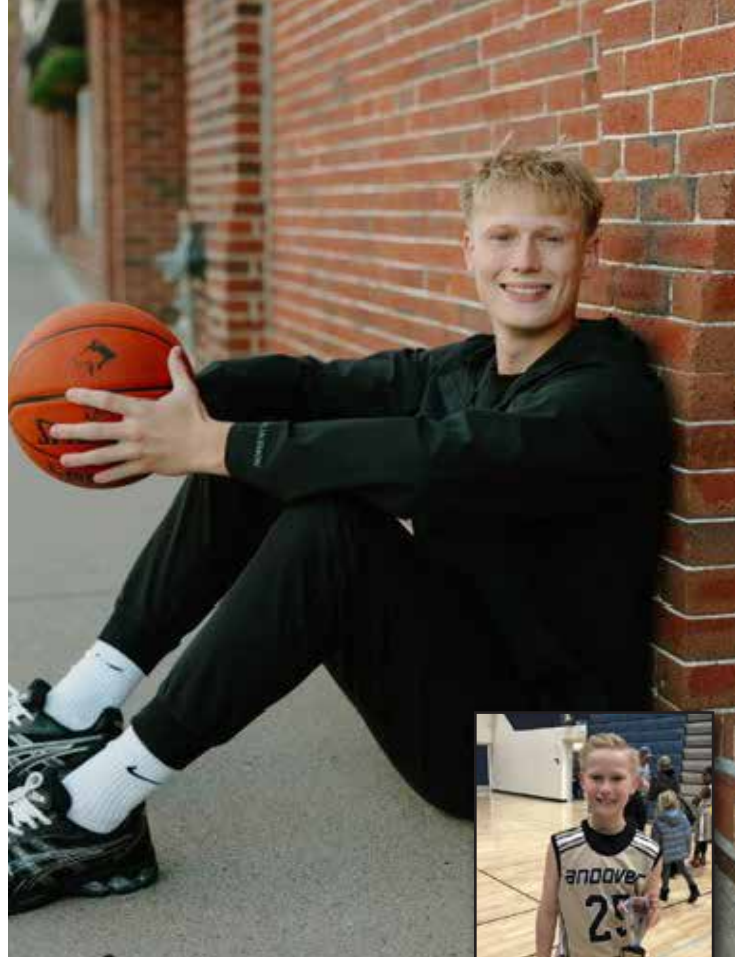

### Varsity Head Coach -

His tenure includes back-to-back section championships in 2021–22 and 2022–23, a state consolation championship in 2021–22, and the honor of being named the 2023 Section 7AAAA Coach of the Year. A former multi-sport athlete in the NWSC, Jeremy played both basketball and tennis in high school before continuing his basketball career at Hamline University. He has also worked for the Minnesota Timberwolves and Lynx in a variety of roles, gaining valuable experience within professional basketball operations.
