Sept. 7, 2025

President Report

- Motion to approve August Board Minutes. Motion passes.
- Motion to vote in Treyvon Edwards as Player Development Director. Motion passes.
- Motion to vote in Lyncee Davies-Peterson as Event Coordinator. Motion passes.

Treasurer Report

- The group reviewed the 2024-2025 budget recap and 2025-2026 forecast. We showed about a \$4500 profit last year and our cash on hand is similar to past healthy years.
- Exec committee will look closer at financials to determine how many paid coaches we can afford and how much we can spend on player development this season.

Registration Director

- Tryouts: Sept. 13-14 at North Middle School (board members arrive at 7 a.m.)
- 143 registrations with many still coming in (15 scholarships)
- Make-up tryout: Thursday, 6:30 at North, parents need to turn in volunteer check and kids will try on uniforms
- Injured players do not need to attend tryouts, but do need to try on uniforms and turn in volunteer check
- Jeff will ask Facilities to close the door between E/W gyms so kids can wait outside the check-in area
- Communication: Reinforce no balls in gyms (leave balls in bag), mandatory parent meeting, times, what to wear (reversible pinney)
- No parents will be allowed near/in gym - only registered coaches on Bobby's Sign In Genius
- After skills session, Bobby & Treyvon will pick up numbers; Andrew/Robyn will sort numbers for Sunday.
- Slight update to tryout approach: Grades 3-5 will complete 2 passes through stations and Grades 6-8 will complete 1 pass through skills stations and play 3 on 3 for the rest of the session. Group discussed the importance of being consistent in grade levels and balancing the objective component of the skills tryout with the subjective portion of the scrimmage tryout to ensure teams are properly formed.
- Todd will create groups based on skills scores, which will translate to starting courts on Sunday. Group discussed that these will be loose groupings and evaluators will move kids between courts.

Coaching Director

- Paid coach budget - exec committee to advise

- Trusted Coaches - Bobby will send link for background checks and concussion trainings to Board members now. Coaches will complete after tryouts.
- Bobby is building a Coach resources hub in Google drive (playbook, practice plans, team talks, etc.)

Facilities Director

- Jeff has reserved practice space starting Sept. 29.
- Discussion that practices will start week of Sept. 29. Bobby and Treyvon to discuss if these will be team-level practices or grade-level clinics.
- Coaches will need to be flexible while multi-sport athletes complete their fall seasons.

Player Development Director
