

BASEBALL PEI POLICY **Provincial Team Code of Conduct**

Athletes that are part of any Baseball PEI provincial team represent their province, community, team, family and themselves. It is a privilege for them to represent their province, and with that privilege comes responsibilities. This Code of Conduct is to be signed by all athletes and one of their parents/guardians. Those who fail to abide by this Code can be subject to a one-year suspension from representing their province at Atlantic and National Championships, subject to review by the Board of Directors of Baseball PEI.

- 1) Appropriate behaviour is expected from all athletes in any circumstance involving the team, including but not limited to games, practices, training, travelling to and from competition, and hotel stays involved with competition.
- 2) Athletes are expected to give maximum effort in games, practices, training and other team events while representing their province.
- 3) Athletes will behave in a respectful manner to fellow teammates, coaches, opponents, officials, and any other person they may deal with while representing their province. Profanity and misbehaviour will not be tolerated.
- 4) Athletes are expected to attend all team meetings, practices, games, training, et cetera unless receiving permission from the coaching staff, and with adequate notice required.
- 5) Athletes will not engage in any activity that is contrary to rules set down by the coaching staff and team officials (which may include breaking team curfews).
- 6) Athletes will not engage in any unbecoming activity that brings disrepute or criticism towards themselves, their team and/or Baseball PEI.
- 7) Athletes will pay all necessary fees associated with the participation on their Provincial team by the specific dates designated by team officials and/or Baseball PEI.
- 8) Athletes will take proper care of their uniform, and return them upon the completion of the National Championship.
- 9) Athletes will not engage in any activities that are contrary to the laws and regulations of Canada, Baseball Canada, and the jurisdiction they are playing in, including any under-age drinking of alcohol, under-age use of tobacco, under-age consumption of marijuana, consumption of illegal drugs, assault, arson, damage to property, theft, etc.
- 10) Athletes will not aid or abet other teammates in any activities that are contrary to the laws and regulations of Canada, Baseball Canada, and the jurisdiction they are playing in, including any under-age drinking of alcohol, under-age use of tobacco, under-age consumption of marijuana, consumption of illegal drugs, assault, arson, damage to property, theft, etc. If athletes witness this type of behaviour by other teammates, they have a duty to report this to either the coaching staff, team official, or chef-de-mission or face discipline.
