



We have moved into Phase 4 guidelines for Restore Illinois. This change will allow us to host games at both rinks. While in Phase 4 there are still capacity limits that we must follow. Below are a list of rules that will apply at both RMPD rinks. If at any time the park district observes spectators not following these rules they will be asked to leave the building.

#### Phase 4 West Meadows and Sports Complex Rules (LTS Classes / Freestyle Ice)

##### Facility:

- All players, coaches, parents and staff must self-check for any COVID-19 symptoms prior to arriving at the buildings.  
If not feeling well, please stay home.
- All players, coaches, parents and staff must wear a face covering, over nose and mouth, at all times in the building,  
Including locker rooms, entry and exit of building.
- Social distancing of at least 6-feet should be followed at all times.
- No out of state visitors allowed.
- No pre-skate warm-ups allowed in the building.
- Skaters have access to locker rooms 12 minutes prior to ice time.
- Skaters must leave locker rooms and rink no more than 12 minutes after ice time ends.

##### Parents:

- All parents must wear a face covering, over nose and mouth, at all times.
- All spectators must be seated in the bleachers and maintain 6-feet of social distance.
- Only 1 parent allowed in rink.
- Siblings are not allowed.
- Parents may enter the building at start of ice time, no earlier.
- Parents must leave the building at end of ice time. No waiting in the lobby for players.
- No loitering in lobby or bleachers.
- Top of WM bleachers off limits to parents.
- Locker room walk-way and stairs at SC are off limits to parents.
- Standing along the glass at either rink is prohibited.
- No food or drink allowed in rink or bleachers (including water and coffee).
- West Meadows will have designated sections "A" and "B" parents will be limited to. Check the locker room board for the sections to sit in. This will allow for easier cleaning of bleachers
- WM entry is through the auto doors, while exit of the building is through the manual doors (on the right).
- Suburban Cook County travel ban is still to be followed.

Anyone found to not be following these rules will be asked to leave the building
