President- Jeanna Townsend-

-Pushing club wide fundraiser (t-shirts, hoodies, etc...) to the Fall

-Irrigation woes at complex.

-Field 1 is being watered normally.

-Sidewalk installation done over the winter around field 9 at request of top soccer for improved access. Installation broke several irrigation lines resulting in large leaks that are

not yet fully repaired (this affects all or a portion of fields 8, 9, 10 watering). Unclear if city will be helping to remediate line breaks caused by sidewalk construction.

-Fields 3-7 and 11-13 the controllers no longer have power due to main north restroom building demolition, it was not anticipated that we would lose power to these controllers and were assured we would have power to the controllers for irrigation this spring. Manually running extension cords to power 2 controllers in the evenings. Challenges in reconnecting power due to city codes and safety with cords on the ground while complex is in use. This will likely be addressed by Shiloh through renovations, but no timing relayed on getting it resolved - pushing for resolution ASAP.

-Fields 14-18 controller was removed from demolished south restroom building but cannot be reinstalled by anyone other than Shiloh due to the scope of work in the renovation project. No timing outlined for being installed - pushing to resolve this ASAP but hands are tied. Currently manually watering zones one at a time, functional, but not ideal.

-New water fountain and bottle filler purchased for east concession through top soccer grant. Waiting on bids through city field maintenance group who is required to oversee/manage the install at the facility at ESC expense (will be paid for with top soccer grant funds).

-Looking for new/used plug aerator for the complex to replace our old one.
