We offer several options for player participation, commitment, and costs. **Prep teams** are for athletes that are not ready for a full club season and **Satellite teams** are directed for non-local HS coaches. Our **Youth Teams** are for players ages 12 and under and our **Core teams** are defined as: **Regional Teams** and **National Teams** (14-18 Black: mandatory travel with primary goal to play through Junior Nationals).

- **Reputable and Qualified Coaches** with backgrounds in technical/tactical skills and game management. Competitive learning environment with respect and fun.
- **Home Based Training Facility:** 6 courts, meeting room and parent viewing mezzanine.
- **Under Armour Gear:** Players receive UA spandex, jerseys, socks, knee pads, warm up jacket, and pants as well as practice shirts.
- **Player Commitment:** All players & Coaches are expected to attend every practice and tournament (excluding school events/medical emergencies). This will require accountability and personal sacrifices. Number of players per team; based on team needs and positions.
- **Playing Time (PT):** All teams at NORCO are managed with team goals being the top priority. PT will be determined by hard work, performance, and attitude. Coaches are committed to improving player's skills to compete for PT while also supporting team needs. Prep and Youth teams are predominately geared more towards equal playing time.
- **Practices (Regional & National):** 2-3 practices a week. Having our own facility allows us to set practice schedules and times for the entire season. Extra practices may be added without additional costs.
- **Skills clinics and Technical training:** offered throughout season. Positional skill academies offered weekly.
- **Collegiate Recruiting Assistance & Seminars** are offered to all NORCO families.
- **Tournament Requirements:** May include mandated housing by tournament host (i.e. Crossroads).
- **USAV Junior National Championships, AAU's or any National Championship:** Will not be included, however if you qualify or receive an at large bid, you will be required to attend at additional cost.
