1. Minutes

The minutes of the September meeting were approved.

2. Treasurers Report

3. Unfinished Business

The amendments to the bylaws were approved with a change for St. Charles to change their color from royal blue to navy. The new bylaws were sent to the Archbishop for final approval.

4. Soccer

Soccer is going well even with the re-scheduling of rain-outs. We have one more year on our contract with the Optimists' field. At this time there is no acceptable replacement field. The CGSAA will become a member of the NW Optimist Club with Keiffer as our representative. He will attend their meetings and be able to hopefully help schedule soccer games.

Please send Keiffer the number of kindergarten children on your teams. He will have medals for every child.

5. Volleyball

The games are going well. A few reminders:

- Please send Beth an accurate account of the win/lose record for your gym.
- Mark the serving line for 4th and 5th grade teams on your courts.
- The end of year tournaments will be on October 27 and 28. The 6th grade tournament will be on Saturday, Oct 27, at Mt. Saint Mary's. The 7th and 8th grades will have their pool play on Saturday, Oct. 27 and bracket play on Sunday, Oct. 28. Both days will be at Bishop McGuinness.
- There will be no 4th grade tournament, but the 5th tournament will be at All Saints.
- All of the questions about the tournaments should go to the schools in charge. These are not CGSAA tournaments.

Schools might raise their tournament fees to eliminate the gate fee.

Beth will bring medals to the next meeting or send them to each school.

There will be a boys' tournament over the weekend of Nov. 3. It will be a one or two day tournament and will be held at John Carroll and Rosary. Details will be sent later this month.

6. Basketball

There were several rule changes approved at the meeting. The up-dated basketball rules will be posted on the website. All other forms have also been updated on the website.

December 1 will be the beginning of all the CGSAA games. February 21 – 24 will be the City Tournament and February 28 – March 3 will be the state tournament. The Tulsa tournament will be December 6 – 9.

There will be a meeting on October 24 at 6:00 at the Pastoral Center. Bring your forms to this meeting. Forms required:

- Final team count is due from each school
- Gym availability dates and exception dates
- Transfer request of students from your school that need a team and how far they are willing to travel to participate at another school.

“Take the Cake”:

Because there is a possibility of McGuinness or Mount St. Marys being in the football playoffs, the tournament will begin on Nov. 8 and possibly skip Nov. 9, but continue on Nov. 10 for fourth, fifth

and sixth grades. The seventh and eighth tournament will begin Saturday night, Nov. 10, and run through Sunday or Monday.

There will be a mandatory coaches meeting this year after our next meeting on Nov. 7. The coaches meeting will begin at 7:00 p.m. at the Pastoral Center.

The league fees will remain the same as last year, \$425.00 per team for 4th through 8th grade. The developmental league fees have yet to be determined.
