Important Information for Spring

Class Information

We have been restricted to maintain an attendance in our facility at no more than 25% of our capacity. To meet that mandate, we have to limit time spent in the building (arrive no more than 20 minutes before your scheduled ice session and depart within 10 minutes after the completion of your session), as well as we are asking that no more than TWO (2) guests should accompany a child who is participating. Siblings are not permitted unless they are registered for another LTS class that day. These policies provide us with the best chance to maximize the use of ice and off-ice facilities, as well as provide us the necessary time to thoroughly sanitize the facility between events.

There will be no makeup classes available under any circumstances. Due to the limited number of skaters allowed on the ice, we will unfortunately not be able to accommodate make up classes until further notice.

Please note: Our back lobby is closed to the public. Parents will not be able to watch our Learn to Skate classes from the back lobby and will be asked to watch from the stands while maintaining social distancing precautions.

Masks, Rental Skates, and Clothing

Masks are required for all skaters and guests in the building at all times. Patrons without a protective face covering will not be permitted in the building or on the ice.

There will be rental skates available for Learn to Skate students. Rental Skates will be available, but limited as they will need to be sanitized between sessions. If you have your own skates, please make sure they still fit and do not have rust on the blades after our extended break.

As a reminder, helmets are not provided. You must bring your own helmet. A helmet is not required, but highly recommended for all beginning levels. For the safety and health of your skater, we strongly recommend gloves be worn at all while on the ice and taken home to be washed following class.

If you are a parent watching your child, a winter coat is advisable as the rink can be cold. Our arena bleachers and lobby tables are current unavailable. Spectators are not allowed to wander the building. They may view their skaters from our lobby staging areas or by standing around the arena glass.
