

CRHL Playoff Rules

2019

1. Seeding. a. Seeding for the post season playoffs are determined by how the teams finished after the completion of the regular season games. b. Higher seed is home team for all playoff games. c. Home team will wear white jerseys, visiting team will wear dark jerseys.

2. Game Format: a. Squirt, Peewee, Bantam, and Midget levels: 3 minute warm-up, 1 minute between periods (or referee discretion). Two run time 15 minute periods. Third period will be 12 minute stop time. One – 30 second timeout is allowed per team. Third period 6 goal run time differential. b. OVERTIME: 3 minute 3 vs 3 overtime. If still tied 3 person shootout. If still tied, 1 for 1 shootout.

3. Game Play a. Team Rosters must be presented to the League Commissioner via association registrars or hockey directors no later than 1 day prior to the scheduled start of the game. b. Teams are not allowed to double roster any player during the season for league play and during league playoffs. c. Playoff rosters will match regular season rosters. d. Only coaches, players and team listed on the teams USA Hockey official roster shall be allowed on the bench. e. Spectators must view the games from the designated area of the playoff site. USA Hockey STAR program guidelines for parent, player,

coach and other spectator behavior shall be enforced by the on ice officials and the host tournament director and staff. f. Each team should be prepared to provide a person to run the penalty box for their respective team. g. The host association shall provide scorekeepers and clock operators. The host organization may request assistance from the Association/Organizations playing in the game if they are short on volunteers.
