

The **SCVAA Post-COVID Waiver** establishes participant acknowledgment of risks and release of liability in relation to sports activities with SCVAA. Below is a summary of key points:

Waiver Agreement Terms

1. **Risk of Injury or Illness:** Participants acknowledge the inherent risks associated with sports activities, which may include serious injury, paralysis, or even death, despite safety measures.
 2. **Communicable Disease Exposure:** There is a risk of exposure to communicable diseases, including COVID-19, through contact with other participants. This risk is unavoidable in close-contact activities.
 3. **Assumption of Risk:** Participants and their guardians assume full responsibility for these risks, including those arising from potential negligence of SCVAA or other parties.
 4. **Compliance with Safety Protocols:** Participants agree to follow all customary safety procedures. If a participant observes any hazard, they agree to notify an official and remove themselves from participation if necessary.
 5. **Release and Waiver of Liability:** The participant and their guardian release SCVAA, its officials, employees, sponsors, and facility owners from any claims of injury, illness, disability, death, or property loss, even if arising from SCVAA's negligence.
 6. **Parental Consent for Minors:** For minors, a parent or guardian must sign the waiver, certifying agreement to release SCVAA from liability and indemnifying SCVAA against any claims.
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Acknowledgment Requirement

Participants or guardians must select "Yes" to acknowledge the waiver, which is a prerequisite for completing the registration. By doing so, they confirm understanding and acceptance of the terms outlined above.
